



Modular Approval Letter

The Device, FCC ID: Y4B-AIC-EGW, is seeking FCC authorization as a modular transmitter. The EUT meets the requirement for modular approval as detailed in FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407. Compliance to each of the requirements is described below:

1. The modular transmitter does **not** have its own RF shielding.
2. The modular transmitter does have buffered modulation/data inputs.
3. The modular transmitter does have its own power supply regulator
4. The modular transmitter complies with the antenna requirement of section 15.203 and 15.204(c)
5. The modular transmitter has been tested in a stand-alone configuration. Power has been supplied via a test fixture with the device fully exposed. The control for the device is available via a connector on the test fixture.
6. The modular transmitter is labeled with its own FCC ID number
7. The modular transmitter complies with all operating requirements and the manufacturer is providing instruction along with the module to explain all such operating requirements.
8. The modular transmitter complies with all applicable RF exposure requirements

Due to not meeting requirement 1, we are requesting Limited Modular Approval.
