This application concerns a request for radio certification of two models; AH20 and AH30.


The differences between model AH20 and model AH30 are:

AH20 has four relays and an extra connector interfacing the 3 terminals of each relay. Each relay has one input (COM) and two outputs (normal closed, normal open).  
Apart from this both models are identical, including identical radio design. In model AH30 the extra connector and relays are not mounted.

Tests have been carried out on model AH20.
