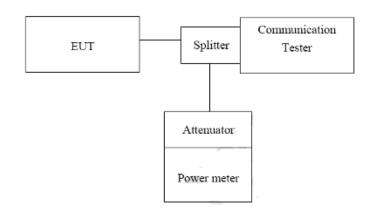

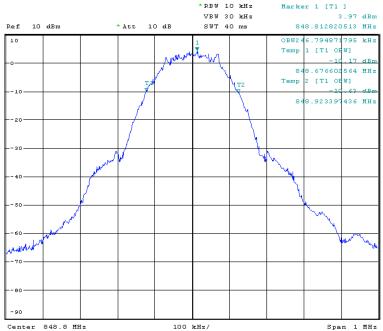

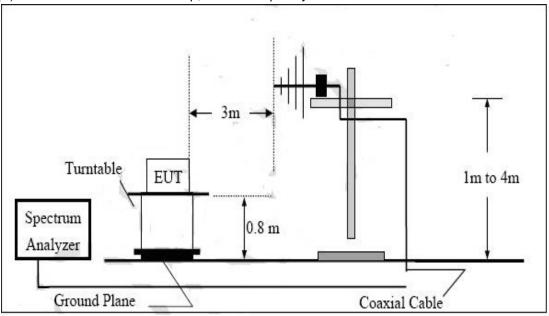

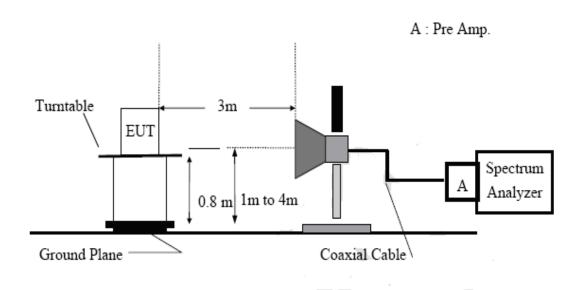

### (B) Radiated emission Test setup frequency over 1GHz:

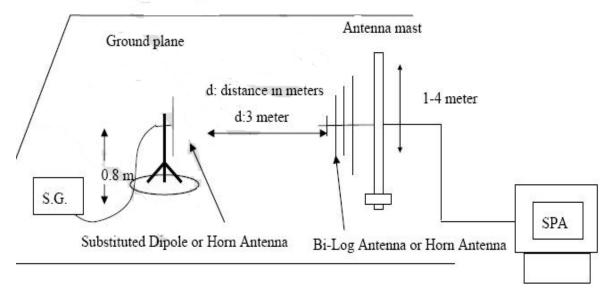

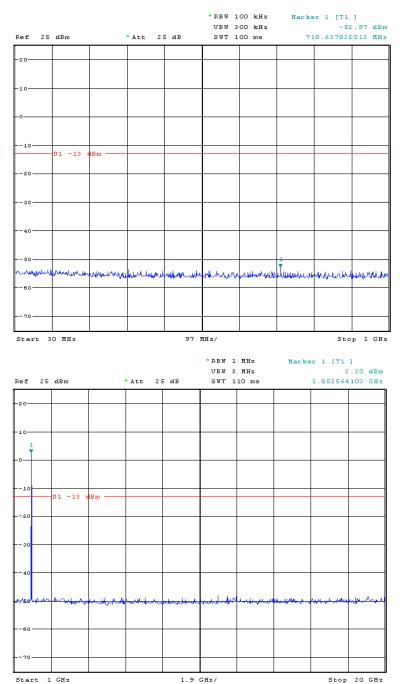
#### **PCS 1900 Channel Low**

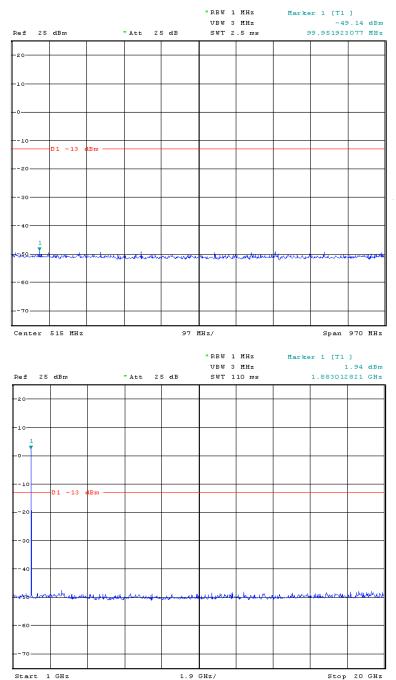
#### **PCS 1900 Channel Mid**

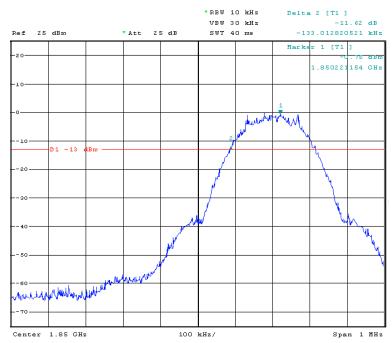
### PCS 1900 Channel High



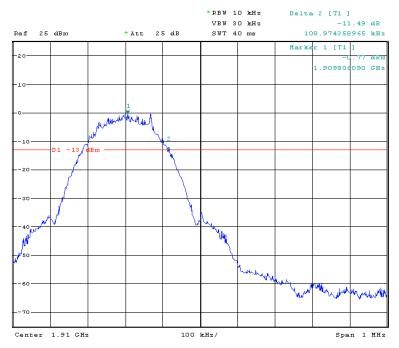

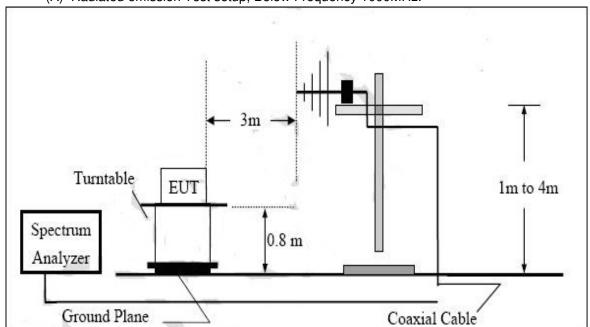

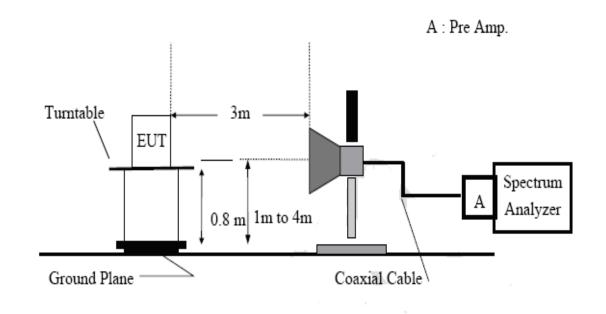
(A) Radiated emission Test setup, Below Frequency 1000MHz:



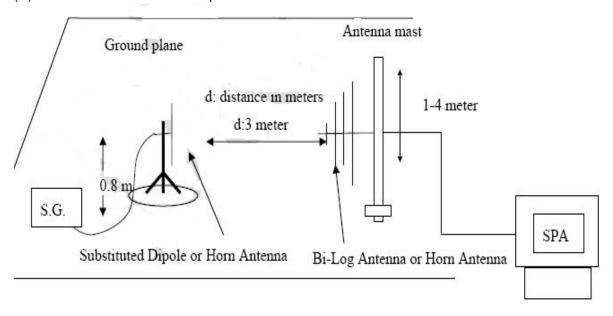

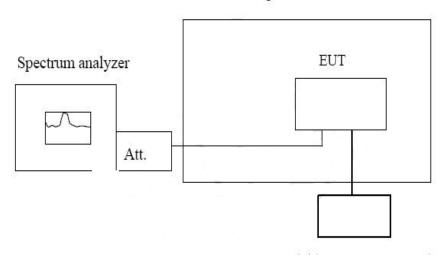

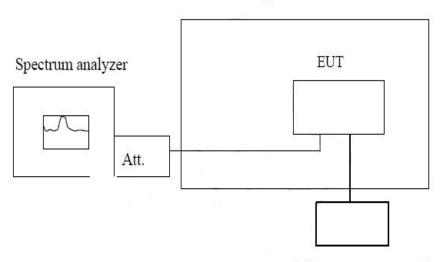
