




## Preparing your phone

You need to insert the SIM card provided by your carrier to use cellular services. Install your phone as shown.



DO NOT insert or remove the SIM cards while your phone is turned on. Doing so can permanently damage your SIM card or your phone. Charge the battery as shown.



Method 1. Connect your phone to a power outlet using the included cable and USB power adapter.
