RE: Request for expedited review for FCC ID YETCELFY-RS225WUA and YETCELFY-RS225CUA

We hereby respectfully request that Expedited Review of the DFS capabilities of the Cel-Fi RS225 Provider Specific Consumer Signal Booster.

This signal booster has already been reviewed for DFS conformance under FCC ID's YETCELFY-RS225CU and YETCELFY-RS225WU. Due to changes in the Part 20 rules for Provider Specific Consumer Signal Boosters, the exact same hardware is being re-submitted under new FCC ID's YETCELFY-RS225WUA and YETCELFY-RS225CUA. No hardware or software changes have been made to the product since the initial FCC grants were obtained. The ONLY reason for the resubmission and filing for a new FCC ID is the change in FCC Equipment Class brought about by the changes in the Part 20 rules for Provider Specific Consumer Signal boosters.
