
FCC E-Label Information Model: K03-100-100

1. Information to be displayed

The device will employ electronic labelling for all required FCC regulatory marks, consistent with the KDB 784748 D2. The information that will be displayed on the e-label and information that will remain in the user manual is shown below:

2. Accessing Electronic Label Information


1. Users are able to access the information in no more than three steps in the APP menu. The actual steps are:

To access the e-label information in Nextivity APP, choose:

Main Menu > Info > Regulatory

No special access codes or permissions are required to go through the above steps.

2. Images of e-label screen




- 3. The information is stored on the APP associate with the device, no special access codes, permissions, special accessories or supplemental plug-ins (e.g., aSIM/USIM card) are required to access the information.
- 4. Users are provided specific instructions on how to access the information.

4. Other considerations

1. The above information must be programmed by the responsible party and the information must be secured in such a manner that third-parties cannot modify it.

The e-label information is pre-programmed by the grantee. The user cannot modify the e-label information.

2. All the applicable regulatory information required on the packaging or user instructions must be provided according to the rules even if it is displayed electronically. For example, hearing aid compatibility (HAC) ratings for the phones as specified in 47 C.F.R. § 20.19.
