RE: PART 15 UNLICENSED MODULAR TRANSMITTER APPROVAL

To Whom It May Concern:

We, *Phoenix Contact GmbH & Co. KG*, hereby requests for part 15 unlicensed modular transmitter approval of our device, described as follows:

Model name: RB-TW-2400 FCC ID: YG3RAD2400A

In FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407 released June 26,2000 there are eight numbered requirements that our device complies with:
