



Introduction

Thank you for using Roman's bluetooth headset, newest function and excellent compatibility. It is your best choice whiles in your office, driving and outdoor activities. It makes you feel the total life protection and the convenience of using wireless product.

Bluetooth wireless technology

Bluetooth wireless technology allows you to connect compatible communication device without cables. The bluetooth connection does not need the phone and the headset to be in line of sight, but both devices should be within 10 meters(30 feet) from each other. Connections can be subjected to interference from obstructions, such as walls or other electronic devices.

The headset is compliant with the bluetooth specification 3.0+EDR supporting the following profiles: Headset Profile 1.1 and Hands-free profile 1.5, A2DP AVRCP(only for stereo headset). Check with the manufacturers of other devices to determine the compatibility of the pairing device.

There may be restrictions on using bluetooth technology in some locations. Check with your local authorities or service providers.

Get started

The headset contains the following parts:

1. Indicating light(The light is red or blue);
2. MFB button(With telephone or power logo);
3. Volume button included + and -;
4. Travel charger(or USB cable), earphone(some headsets need earphone);
5. Earhook;
6. Microphone;
7. Earbud cushions;(Small, middle and large, 3 different sizes);

8. LCD display, Vibrate and Buzzer;(Some headsets have these functions)

Before you start using the headset, you must charge it fully and connect the headset with a compatible phone or device.

Note: Parts of the headset are magnetic, metallic material may be attracted to the headset. Do not place credit cards or other magnetic storage media near the headset, because information stored on them maybe erased.

Second Time Using

When attempting to reconnect the headset to your mobile phone, your mobile phone will prompt you to accept the connection request to the headset pairing name, and an option will not ask the pairing again. Please accept the connection, and if you select "Don't ask this again", your phone will automatically accept future connection requests from your bluetooth headset.

Indicator light instruction

Blue indicator light turns on for 3 seconds or the Red and Blue indicator lights turns on automatically, it shows in pairing mode.Red indicator light turns on shows the headset is off working. Blue indicator light is shining fastly that shows in searching mode. Blue indicator light is shining slowly that shows in connection mode(5-8seconds).

Pairing: in switching "On" mode, press the MFB key for 5 or more and you will hear one "TONE" or "buzzer" tone, do not release your hand until the the Blue light

turn on or Red&Blue lights blink alternately, which shows it is in pairing mode. Now you can operate your mobile phone to search the bluetooth headset.

Connecting : Turn on your mobile phone's Bluetooth to search for the bluetooth headset, found it, please choose and confirm it, and input password 0000 if needed, choose headset service to connect successfully.

Answer calling: when calling, some headset has a "TONE" or "buzzer" tone, just press the MFB key shortly to enter Talking mode.

Reject calling: when calling, press the MFB key shortly for 2 to 3 seconds or longer and release your hand until you hear a TONE, then it will reject calling in. End calling: when in talking mode, press the MFB key shortly to end the call.

Volume Control : If your headset have volume control, when talking, press the + to increase the Volume, short press - to lower the volume.

Forward/backward : when playing music by using stereo bluetooth headset, press the volume sign (+) for 5 to 10sec to get the previous song, press the volume sign (-) to get the next song.

Pause playing: when playing music by using stereo bluetooth headset, shortly press the MFB key to pause playing, shortly press the MFB again to go on playing. Setting music: If connecting successfully, most mobile phone automatically support playing music by using bluetooth headset, but some mobile phone need to be set : when playing music ,please choose bluetooth A2DP service to play music. For more details, please refer to the User Manual of your mobile phone.(only for stereo bluetooth headset)

Talking Switcher: when talking using bluetooth headset, keep pressing the MFB twice or longer press to talk to Switch to the mobile phone, repeat the above operation to go on talking with the bluetooth headset.

Re-dial last number: when in a standby mode, press the MFB key longer or shortly press it twice to redial the last call.

Voice Dialing: when in a standby mode, keep pressing the MFB twice to operate the voice dialing on the mobile phone, enabled voice control. Then again keep pressing MFB twice to cancel it.

Multi-point Function Operating:

1. Press and hold MFB until the indicator light turns on in blue.
2. Activate the Bluetooth feature on the phone, and set the phone to search for Bluetooth devices.
3. Select the headset from the list of found devices.
4. Enter passcode "0000" if prompted by the phone. If the headset pairs correctly you will hear a beep and the blue indicator light will flash five times, in some phones you may need to make the connection separately after pairing.
5. Turn off your headset.
6. Turn on your headset again.
7. Activate the Bluetooth feature on another phone and set the phone to search for Bluetooth device. Enter passcode "0000" if prompted by the phone. If the

headset pairs correctly you will hear a beep and the blue indicator light will flash five times, in some phones you may need to make the connection separately after pairing.

8. Turn off the headset again.
9. At last, turn on the headset. You will find it connects two mobiles successfully.

Headset Parameter Setting

The following steps can recover headset parameter setting.

1. Pairing status ----The Blue indicator light or the Blue and Red indicators light alternatively, press MFB for 2 seconds then release it, the Blue and Red indicators will be flashing at the same time.
2. Insert the AC charger to the headset, press volume up or volume down till the Blue indicator flash three times.
3. Connect the charging pin of the USB cable to the charging socket of the headset, press MFB till the Blue indicator flash three times.

Turn Off The Headset

When the headset is working, press MFB for 3 seconds till the Blue and Red indicator flash at the same time, then the headset turns off.

Chargers and batteries

Check the model number of any charger before using it with this device.

check with your dealer. When you disconnect the power cord of any enhancement, grasp and pull the adapter , not the cord.

Charge the battery

This device has an internal built-in, rechargeable battery. Do not attempt to remove the battery from the device as you may damage the device.

1. The Bluetooth Headset will emit an intermittent beep and flash Red indicator when the battery is running low and requires recharging.
2. Connect the charging pin of the USB cable to the charging socket of the headset.
3. Connect the other end of the USB cable to the charger.
4. The Red indicator light turns on.
5. The red indicator light shuts off when the headset is fully charged(approximately 1-2hour)

Often problems and solutions

Problems description	Cause	solution
Can not start	The power used up	Charge the battery fully before use
Can not charge	Press MFB button too short	Press the MFB button for 3 seconds to re-start the headset
	Plug is not placed well	Check the Plug well

Can not close	Operate wrongly made of the headset/software error	Plug to charger to reset
Can not find the headset when searching paring devices	The headset is not in searching status Mobile phone Bluetooth software error	Set the headset in a searching status Close the mobile phones and re-start.
