一. Electrical System Parameters

- 1、Work voltage: DC6V
- 2、Quiescent current: $\leq 5\text{UA}$
- 3、Working current: $\leq 21\text{MA}$
- 4、Transmitting power: $\leq 100\text{MW}$
- 5、Working frequency: 433MHZ
- 6、Modulation mode: ASK
- 7、Encode type: learning code

Learning Instructions:

- 1) Push & hold receiver button for 3 seconds (light starts flashing faster),release button.
- 2) Press "on/off" button on transmitter (light starts on/constant) & then release (light goes back to the faster speed).
- 3) Option:learn 2nd or 3rd transmitter at this time.
- 4) Push & release receiver button to turn off learn mode (light will stay on/constant).
