1. The modular transmitter must have its own RF shielding.	The module has its own RF shielding. Please see photo.pdf
2. The modular transmitter must have buffered modulation/data inputs.	The modular has buffered data inputs, it is integrated in chip RT5370. Please see schematic.pdf
3. The modular transmitter must have its own power supply regulation.	Yes, it's done by IC LSP1301, Please see schematic.pdf
4. The modular transmitter must comply with the antenna requirements of Section 15.203 and 15.204(c).	The U15A-U meets the FCC antenna requirements. It has a PCB antenna. Please see photo.pdf
5. The modular transmitter must be tested in a stand-alone configuration, i.e., the module must not be inside another device during testing.	The U15A-U was tested in a stand-alone configuration. Please see conducted set-up photo.pdf
