# Manual

The Router is sold as OEM and Aftermarket product.

In the case of an Aftermarket business, Alligator ensures to print the FCC/IC manual statement on the packaging and/or separate printed manual that comes with the product to notify the end-user of the commercial product.

In the case of an OEM business, Alligator ensures to supply the FCC manual statement to the OEM / Reseller of the product dictating what must be included in the end-user's manual for the commercial product.
