Vehicle does not respond to controls.	<ol> <li>Transmitter controller battery is drained. Replace the controller battery.</li> <li>The vehicle is likely out of range. Bring controller closer to the vehicle. If problem persists, remove the controller batteries and replace with new batteries, then restart (ON/OFF) the vehicle.</li> <li>Interference from surrounding electrical machinery. 




#### **ADULT INSTALLATION REQUIRED**

#### **MUDFLAP**


Move the switch at the bottom of the Mudflap to the OFF mode.
Use a Phillips Head screwdriver (not included) to remove the cover.



Remove the old batteries and insert the new (6 X 1.5V AA Size (LR6)) batteries with the correct polarity indicated inside the box. Screw the cover back in.




Move the switch to the ON mode to activate all play features of the Mudflap. Move the switch to the OFF mode when not in use to help save battery life.




#### **REMOTE CONTROL**

Move the switch at the bottom of the Remote Control to the OFF mode.
Use a Phillips Head screwdriver (not included) to remove the cover.




Remove the old batteries and insert the new (2 X 1.5V AAA Size (LR03)) batteries (not included) with the correct polarity indicated inside the box. Screw the cover back in.

Move the switch to the OFF mode when not in use to help save battery life.






