1. Basic knowledge



1.1. Introduction

The color screen phone is designed for GSM network environment, and the phone in addition to basic call

functions, the unit also provides you with, including phone book, profiles, information, audio players, games, alarm clock, calculator, time Date, Automatic Turning, including a variety of practical features to facilitate your work and leisure activities.

1.2. Safety instructions

If your phone is lost or stolen, please immediately notify the telecommunications sector, or sales points, to disable the SIM card. This will allow you to take calls from others caused economic losses.

When you and your sales points or contact the telecommunications sector, they need to know your phone's IMEI number (printed on the label on the back of the phone, remove the battery can be found). Please copy the numbers to stay and keep for future needs.

To make you safer use of mobile phone, take precautions, such as: set the phone SIM card PIN code, PIN code to prevent your SIM card to be used by others

without permission. Leave the car, do not easily see the phone in the office, carry or locked in the trunk.

1.3. Safety Warnings and Precautions

Before using your phone, please read these notes carefully to ensure correct use of mobile phones.

1.3.1. Universal Precautions

On the plane, in hospitals where such use is prohibited, please turn off the phone, otherwise it will affect electronic equipment and medical devices work properly. In these places the phone, please observe the relevant provisions of the place.

Please strictly abide by the seat of the car using your cell phone laws and regulations. If you use the phone while driving, please observe the following rules: focus on driving, pay attention to road conditions; if the phone has a speakerphone, use hands-free calls; if driving conditions are bad, please stop, and then make or receive Tel.

Close to the storage of fuel, chemicals or explosives and other places, obey the laws, regulations and related mark. Keep the phone, battery and charger in places difficult to reach children, so their children as a toy, causing injury. Your phone can only use the specified batteries, chargers and other accessories, to avoid damage. Use other batteries, chargers may cause leakage, overheating, burst, fire and other faults.

Do not weak signal or use the phone near high-precision electronic devices. Radio wave interference may cause the misuse of these electronic devices.

Do not crashing, shaking or throwing the device, mobile phone malfunction or fire.

Do not put batteries, cell phone, charger in a microwave oven or high-pressure equipment, or fire may cause circuit damage or other accidents. Do not use with flammable gases, local phone, mobile phones may cause malfunction or fire.

Do not put the phone in high temperature, high humidity

or where there is a lot of dust, or mobile phones may cause malfunction.

Do not place the phone on uneven or unstable areas, to prevent malfunction or damage caused by falling.

1.3.2. Notes on using mobile phones

Do not disassemble or modify the phone, otherwise it will cause the phone to the damage, leakage and circuit failure.

Do not knock hard on the LCD screen or use it to beat other things, otherwise it will cause damage the LCD panel and LCD liquid leakage.

If the liquid crystal fluid into the eye would be the risk of blindness. Then immediately flush eyes with water (do not rub the eye), and immediately to the hospital.

In rare cases, cell phone use in certain models of the car when the car may have an adverse impact on electronic equipment. Then please do not use mobile phones to avoid loss of security.

If your vehicle is equipped with air bag, do not put the phone over the air bag or air bag can hit the area later, so the air bag inflates, the phone by the strong force, may cause serious harm to the owners.

Do not use needles, pen touch keys and other sharp objects, otherwise it will damage the phone or a miss.

If the antenna is damaged, please do not use the phone, or may cause bodily injury.

Avoid phone too close to the magnetic cards and other magnetic objects, mobile phone radiation may remove the floppy disk, card, credit card information stored on. Please thumbtacks and other small metal objects away from the local mobile phone handset. Working with magnetic speaker, will attract small metal objects, which may cause bodily injury or damage to your phone.

Avoid phone damp and water or other liquids into the phone, cause the phone to short circuit, leakage or other failure.

If possible, stay away from fixed telephone, television, radio and office automation equipment, use the phone,

so as not to affect the use of these devices and mobile phones effect.

1.3.3 Notes on batteries

Do not disassemble or modify the battery, otherwise it will cause leakage, overheating, explosion or fire.

Do not throw old batteries in normal household waste. In a clearly defined place for disposal of batteries, please follow the instructions provided treatment.

Do not put batteries in a fire, otherwise it will cause the battery to ignite or burst.

battery, do not force the pressure, otherwise it will cause battery leakage, overheating, explosion or fire.

Do not use wires, needles and other metal objects to short-circuit; not to the battery and necklaces and other metal objects together, otherwise it will cause leakage, overheating, explosion or fire.

Do not solder the battery contacts, otherwise it will cause them to leak, overheat, burst or fire. If the battery fluid into the eye will be the risk of blindness, then please do not rub your eyes, use the rinse, and then immediately to the hospital.

Do not near the fire or heater or other hot places to place the battery, otherwise it will cause leakage, overheating, explosion or fire.

If the battery is in use, charging or save exception occurred during heating, discoloration, deformation phenomena, discontinue use and replace the new battery.

If the battery fluid leakage across the skin, clothing, which may cause skin burns, immediately rinse with water if necessary seek medical treatment immediately.

If the battery fluid leakage or a strange odor, immediately next to it to take away from the flame to avoid fire or burst.

Do not expose the battery to moisture, otherwise it will cause the battery to overheat, smoke or corrosive.

Do not place in direct sunlight and other heat or place used batteries, which can cause fluid leakage or overheating, may reduce performance and shorten service life.

Do not charge it continuously for more than 24 hours.

Keep the battery from direct sunlight, cool well ventilated place.

Phone battery life is limited. Battery charging time is gradually shortened frequent. Repeatedly charging fails, the battery is dead and should be replaced new battery type specified.

2. Function Menu

■ 2.1. Information

2.1.1.Write Message

You can use this function write a short message. Enter the information you want to send, you can send, input, advanced options, save drafts and other operations.

■ Send: Edit the information interface, when the

editing information is complete, if you are a direct recovery information to the recipient, then enter the recipient's number display screen, and then click send; if new information is sent into the phone book to select a number .

- Input Method: You can choose English capital, lowercase, digital input and other input method.
- Ssave: save the message to the Drafts section.

2.1.2. Inbox

Store your received messages.

Choose a message, you can view, reply, call, forward, delete, delete all, save, tag and other operations.

- View: You can view the contents of the selected message.
- Re: reply message to the sender.
- Call: Call the sender.
- Forward: The article text messages to other contacts.
- Delete: delete the article text.

- Delete all: Delete all text messages.
- save: choose which messages to save to the SIM card or mobile phone.

2.1.3.Outbox

Failed to send the message store, select a message, you can view, resend, edit, delete, delete all, check the information status, information operations.

2.1.4.Drafts

Store the edited text. Choose a message, you can view, send, edit, delete, delete all other operations.

2.1.5.Sent

Store text messages sent successfully. Choose a message, you can view, forward, delete, delete all other operations.

- View: View the article text.
- Forward: forward the message to others that article.
- Delete: delete the article text.
- Delete all: delete all messages sent mailbox.

2.1.6.Delete information

You can select the Inbox, Drafts, Outbox, Sent messages, delete all the information.

2.1.7.Cell Broadcast

Press the left soft key to enter the cell broadcast interface, you can proceed as follows.

- receive mode: Turn on or turn off cell broadcasting function.
- channel settings: Optional add, delete, edit the original channel.
- Language: choose to receive broadcasts in all languages.

■ read information: press the left soft key can read the received broadcast information.

2.1.8. Setting

Pattern is set, voice mail, information validity, status settings, storage state, the preferred storage location, such as the preferred connection option.

2.2.Phone Book

You can save names and phone numbers on the SIM card or mobile phone and other information.

2.2.1.View contact

Contact interface in the view, select a contact, press "Options" to enter the option list interface, the interface in the list of options you can do the following operations.

- View: View the selected call record details.
- send SMS: You can send SMS to this number.
- Call: call this number directly.

- IP Dial-up: the selection of the directory number for dial-up IP.
- Edit: the selection of the telephone directory business card information to re-modified and saved.
- Delete: the phone number from the phone or SIM card removed.
- copy: the SIM card or mobile phone, copy the number.
- Mobile: The mobile phone records from the phone to the SIM card or From SIM card to mobile phone.
- caller groups: group name can be edited, select the ringtones, pictures, to highlight the personality characteristics of the group, when group member calls, you can set the display to show the distinction between individual groups.

2.2.2. Phone book settings

View phone book set in the interface, click "Options" to enter the option list interface, the interface in the list of options you can do the following operations.

preferred storage location: Select location for a SIM

card or phone or both.

- Speed Dial: You can turn on or off speed dial feature, set the speed dial list.
- my number: I edit my phone number.
- other numbers: Edit other phone number.
- Storage Status: Display the SIM card, phone memory status.
- Copy contacts: all the phone numbers from your SIM card to phone or from phone to SIM card.
- mobile contacts: all the phone numbers from your SIM card to mobile phone or from phone to SIM card.
- Delete all contact: Remove the SIM card or phone all the numbers.

2.3.Call Center

2.3.1. Call History

Display your recent call history.

Dialed

Shows you a list of recently dialed phone numbers.

Interface in the list of dialed numbers, press the "option" to enter the option list interface, the interface in the list of options you can do the following operations.

- View: You can query the record details, including name, number, call time, talk time and other information.
- Call: call this number directly.
- send SMS: You can send SMS to this number.
- save: You can add the number to the SIM card or phone.
- added to the blacklist: the phone calls which have been added to the blacklist.
- Call editor: to Add the numbers have been recorded in the phone book.
- Delete: deletion of the article has been dialed.

Received calls

Showing you has recently received a list of phone numbers. Operation with the dialed phone.

Missed calls

Indicates that you have not recently received a list of phone numbers. Operation with the dialed phone.

All phone

Displays a record of all telephone numbers.

Operation with the dialed phone.

2.3.2.Call setting

My numbers

Set the number as a local number. Whether to support the function and stored on your SIM card number.

Call waiting

You can start, shut down, the query feature.

Call Transfer

You can set up the transfer of all voice calls, not transfer contact, no answer, busy transfer, transfer all the data, cancel the transfer.

Call restrictions

You can set the broadcast limit, restrict calls, cancel all, change your password.

Advanced Settings

You can set up blacklist, automatic redial, IP dialing, background sound, talk time display, call tips, auto limit, response mode.

2.4.Setting

2.4.1.Profiles

Profiles with standard / Silent / Meeting / Outdoor / my other models.

You can start of each model, personal settings, reset and other operations. In the personal settings, you can do the following:

- Alert type: You can set the ring only, vibration only, vibration and ring vibration then ring。
- Ring Type: You can choose to repeat, getting stronger, soon.
- Ringtone: You can set the incoming / outgoing / message / power on and power off ringtone and volume

2.4.2.Phone settings

■ Time Date: You can set the phone time and date.

- Language: You can select Phone language.
- Preferred input method: You can select the input method.
- Display: you can set the wallpaper, screen saver, boot animation, animation and other operations shut down.
- Shortcuts: You can set shortcuts.
- Dedicated keys: You can specify up and down left and right function key settings.
- Flight mode: You can select normal mode, flight mode, boot ask.

2.4.3. Security Settings

In the Security Settings screen, click "Options" to enter the option list interface, the interface in the list of options you can do the following operations.

■ SIM card security settings: you can set the feature on or off, if the PIN code lock function on, each time using a SIM card requires a PIN code. Enter the correct order to use the SIM card. Can also PIN code, PIN2 code to be modified.

- Mobile Security: You can turn on or turn off this feature if the lock on the phone, mobile phone every time you turn to enter the password. Enter the correct, before using the phone.
- keypad lock: can be set to turn off the keyboard lock feature can also be set to standby mode automatically lock the keypad after a certain period of time.

2.4.4.Factory Reset

This feature is used in some phone settings to factory defaults. To determine the recovery, you need to enter the phone lock code. Enter the correct, display message, press the left soft key to confirm, press the right soft key to return. The default code is 0000.

2.5.FM radio

To use the phone listening to the radio, set the headset cable into the phone's headset jack. After entering the phone will display the search menu to the default broadcast channel or frequency. Press the left soft key to select "Options", you can do the following:

- channel list: Select the search or preset channel, press the left soft key can be edited on the selected channel, including channel name and frequency.
- manually enter: In the editing interface input frequency.
- Automatic Search: Automatic forward or backward channel, a channel is found after a search will automatically stop.
- Setting: Turns off the background player, set the on / off speaker phone, open the phone speaker after broadcast through loudspeakers.

2.6.Additional features

2.6.1 Calendar

This feature allows you to view calendar. In the Calendar interface, you can do the following operations.

- jump to the specified date: Enter the specified month, day, to quickly jump to a specified date.
- Switch to today: You can switch to display today's

date.

2.6.2.Alarm

You can edit the alarm time, tone, repeat mode. Select the alarm, press the left soft key to select Edit to enter the alarm settings page.

- Start: on or off the alarm function, press the left and right arrow keys to set.
- Alarm Time: set the alarm time.
- Repeat: optional ring once a day ringing, or custom ring.
- Alarm tone: set different ring tones or FM broadcasts.
- Snooze time: to set the alarm ringing time interval.
- prompt type: set ring / vibration / vibration and ring the prompt way.

2.6.3. Calculator

This feature allows you to phone a calculator, some simple add, subtract, multiply, and divide operations.

2.7. Games

The phone has gaming features, you can relax and entertainment. Game instructions in the game help. The game can also be set on or off background music, sound, vibration of the game, the volume settings.

3. Care and maintenance

Battery Maintenance

- ·This phone is a rechargeable battery as a power source. When the power is weak, the battery charge. To maintain battery life, charging the battery will run out before the best.
- ·When the battery charger when not in use, turn it with the electricity supply source separation. Do not connect the battery charger with more than one week, over-charging will shorten battery life.
- ·Temperature limits of the battery can be charged.

Therefore, before charging, the battery may need to look cool or warm. If the battery temperature exceeds 40 degrees Celsius, the battery will not charge.

- •The battery used in its original purposes, to avoid short circuit. When the conductive material directly connected to the battery positive and negative will cause a short circuit.
- ·Do not use damaged batteries.
- •The battery in extremely cold or extremely hot place will lead to shortened battery life, battery exposed to cold or hot places may cause the phone function does not play, even if the battery is fully charged, too.
- -Do not place batteries in a fire! Follow the local laws and regulations dealing with waste batteries.

Phone Maintenance

The following suggestions will help you take care of your mobile phone:

•The phone with all accessories away from children can touch the place.

- •Please keep the body dry, the liquid will cause the metal circuit corrosion.
- •Please stay away from the body heat, high temperature will shorten the life of electronic devices, the plastic melt and damage the battery.
- •Do not attempt to open or cell phone case the disintegration of non-professional demolition may cause damage to the body.
- ·Do not use acid or strong alkaline detergent body.
- •Only use mobile phone original accessories. Violation of these will void the warranty.

4. Safety Information

When you use your phone, you must comply with in order to protect users and their environment and to develop safety regulations.

Traffic Safety

- ·Unless there is an emergency, if not installed to ensure safety and freedom of movement of the hands-free device, please do not use mobile phones while driving, to ensure that you concentrate on driving, please park your car to a safe place and then use the phone. Please observe the relevant laws and regulations.
- •There is not enough protection in the case, the car in certain electronic systems may be affected by the impact of radio waves transmitted from your phone.
- ·We recommend that you only have an external antenna car cell phone use.
- Only a qualified technician to install your phone in your car.

Flight Safety

Before boarding an aircraft off your mobile phone, because it affects the operation of the aircraft and the entire cellular network. Use of mobile phones on aircraft is illegal and in violation of these safety regulations will be prosecuted or denial of service caused by the GSM

network.

Environmental Safety

- Remember that in any place to comply with existing special regulations in place prohibiting the use of mobile phones, or may cause interference or danger must be shut down.
- ·Any wireless transmission equipment, including cellular phones, may interfere improperly interfere with medical equipment. If you have any questions in this regard may be made to a physician or medical device manufacturer.
- ·Your phone may have hearing aids, pacemakers and other medical electronic equipment interference. Follow your doctor or medical device manufacturer's recommendations.
- ·May lead to an explosion in any place, such as gas stations, chemical plants, the user turn off the phone.
- ·Comply with the restrictions on using wireless devices.
