

Before You Begin


To use some of the best features of your new Tablet, you will need to connect to the Internet. Don't worry, it's easy. The First-Time Setup will walk you through the process. To connect your Tablet to the Internet, you must have an Internet connection and a wireless network.



You can always use your Tablet without an Internet connection, but some features will be unavailable.

First-Time Setup

Press and hold the POWER button for2 seconds to turn the Tablet on.



2. Select the language. Press the arrow to move to the next screen.



3 Select WiFi connection.



4 Once the WiFi is connected you can set up your Google account.



5. Touch the circle to see all apps and to begin setup.



6 Choosing apps to add to your Home screen. Press "OK" to start.



7. Touch the desired apps and hold it to drop it onto your Home screen. Note: You can move the apps icon by holding it down and dragging it to the desired location. Also, to remove the apps icon hold down and drag to the top where it says X.



Wi-Fi Setup

To connect your Tablet to a wireless network, go to "Settings". Tap the Wi-Fi to "ON".



It will show you a list of available Wi Fi networks. Tap the name of your network (and enter your password if needed).



GMAIL Setup

To add a Gmail account tap the GMAIL icon. Either set up an existing or new account.





2 Inset SD Card containing the Flextime or Pondwatch video.








You will be asked to select a Player 5. You will be asked to come of the play the desired file. Choose OWL player and press "ALWAYS".

Sleep Mode and Unlocking

The Tablet screen will turn off automatically after min-1 ute if it is not being used. Sleep mode can be changed by going to "Settings" \rightarrow "Display" \rightarrow "Sleep". This is called sleep mode. You can also press the Power button to put the Tablet in sleep mode.



To wake the Tablet, press the Power button. The Lock screen will be displayed.

Unlock the Tablet by taping the lock symbol and sliding it off the screen.

- Search Lets you search the Market for apps



You will need an Internet connection to download new apps from the Play Store. If you don't already have a free Google account, you can sign up for one in the Google Play Store.




Charging Tablet

Connect the Micro USB Cable to the Tablet.




- 2 Connect the USB Cable to the power adaptor, then connect the power adaptor to an electrical outlet. (Another option is to connect USB Cable to a computer)
- 3. The ≠ symbol in the battery icon means the Tablet is charging. When the battery icon has full bars, the Tablet is fully charged.

- SD Card Slot
- With the Tablet facing down, open the
- SD Card door by sliding the door to the right. Once unlocked the door will spring open.



 Load SD memory card (up to 32GB not included) into the SD CARD slot with the connectors facing down.

Reset

Tap "Settings" \rightarrow "Back up and Reset". This will erase all data from your tablet's external storage, including your Google account, system settings, app settings, and downloaded apps.



Important Safety Information

Read all the safety information below before using your Tablet. For additional information, read the User Manual available directly through an application in your Tablet.

DRIVING SAFELY

Use of your Tablet while driving may cause distractions and may be prohibited in some places. Always comply with local laws and regulations when driving. Driving safely is your primary responsibility, but if using your Tablet, NEVER type or read email or messages, navigate on the web or perform any other activity that takes your attention from driving.

ALWAYS keep your eyes on the road and your hands on the wheel, use voice-activated commands and focus on your driving.

SEIZURES/BLACKOUTS

Some people may be susceptible to epileptic seizures or strokes when exposed to flashing lights such as when playing games or watching video, even if those conditions have not been previously diagnosed.

If you or anyone in your family has a history of seizures or strokes, or if you have any other reason to think you or someone under your supervision may be susceptible to epileptic seizures or strokes, consult a doctor before playing games or watching video. WARNING ABOUT HEARING DAMAGE

Exposure to loud sounds can damage your hearing causing hearing loss and tinnitus (ringing or buzzing in the ears). With continued exposure to loud noises, ears may become accustomed to the sound level, which may result in permanent damage to hearing without any noticeable discomfort. Loud Sounds + Time = Hearing Loss

REPETITIVE MOTION

Repetitively performing actions such as press-

ing keys or typing, may result in occasional discomfort in your hands, arms, shoulders, neck, or other parts of your body. Take breaks often and if you continue to have discomfort during or after such use, stop use and see a doctor.

GLASS PARTS

Your Tablet may contain glass parts. Dropping your Tablet on a hard surface or a substantial impact to your Tablet could break this glass. If the glass breaks, do not touch or attempt to remove it. Stop using your Tablet until the glass is replaced by an authorized service center.

POTENTIALLY EXPLOSIVE ATMOSPHERES

When you are in an area with potentially explosive atmosphere turn off your Tablet. Do not remove, install, or charge batteries to avoid creating sparks that can cause an explosion or fire resulting in serious injury or even death. Areas with potentially explosive atmospheres are often, but not always, clearly marked. Potential areas may include fueling areas, fuel or chemical transfer or storage facilities, or areas where the air contains chemicals or particles, such as grain dust, or metal powders, or areas where you would normally be advised to turn off your engine.
