

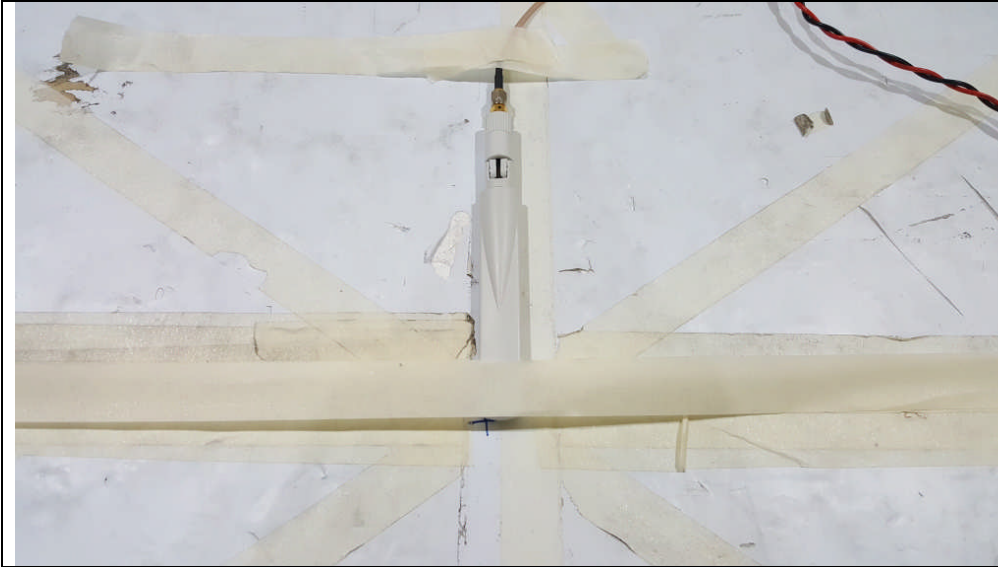

Test setup photos of EUT

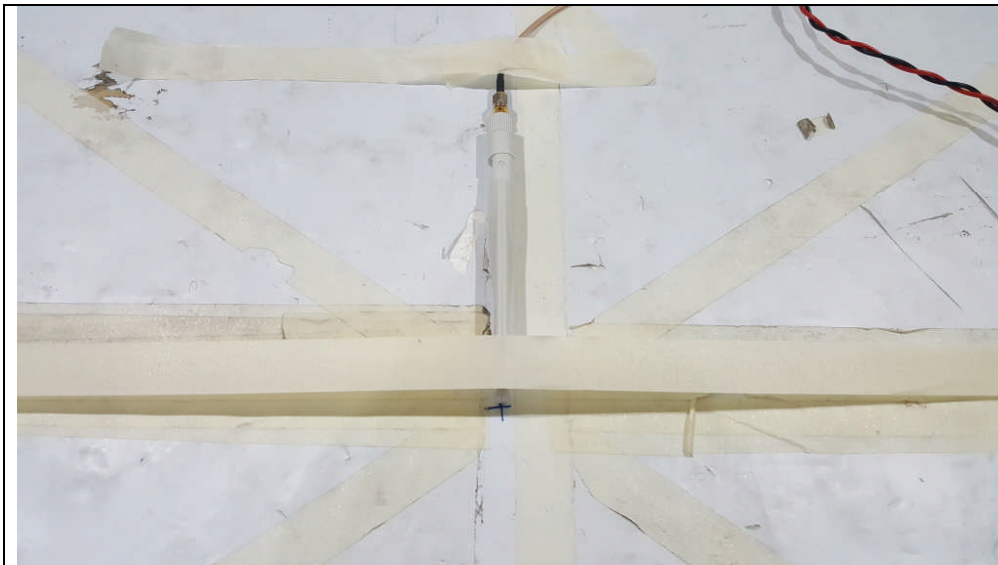
1. Orthogonal planes of EUT

- The testing was set in the two orthogonal planes and measured for each position (X, Y, Z).

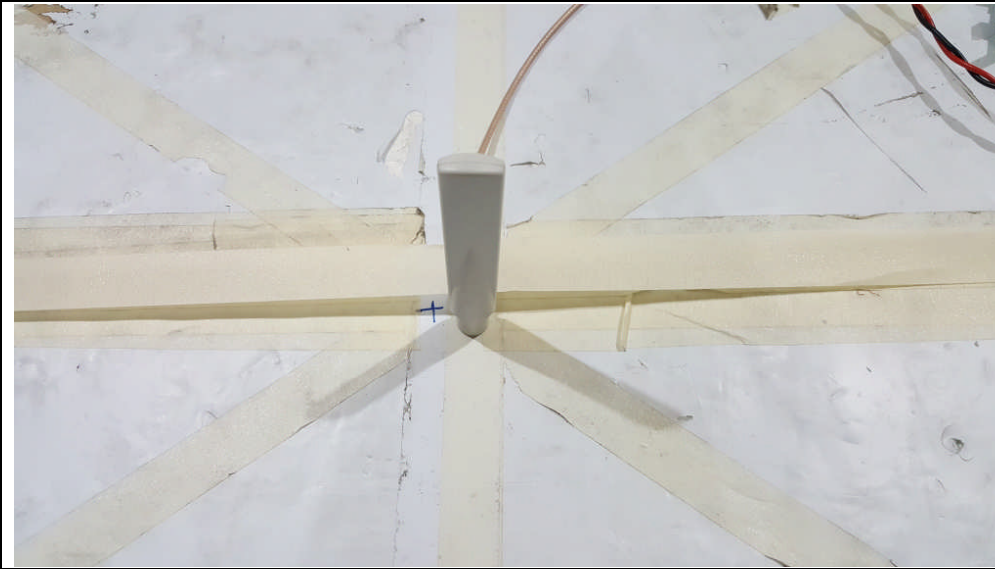
A. X-axis



B. Y-axis



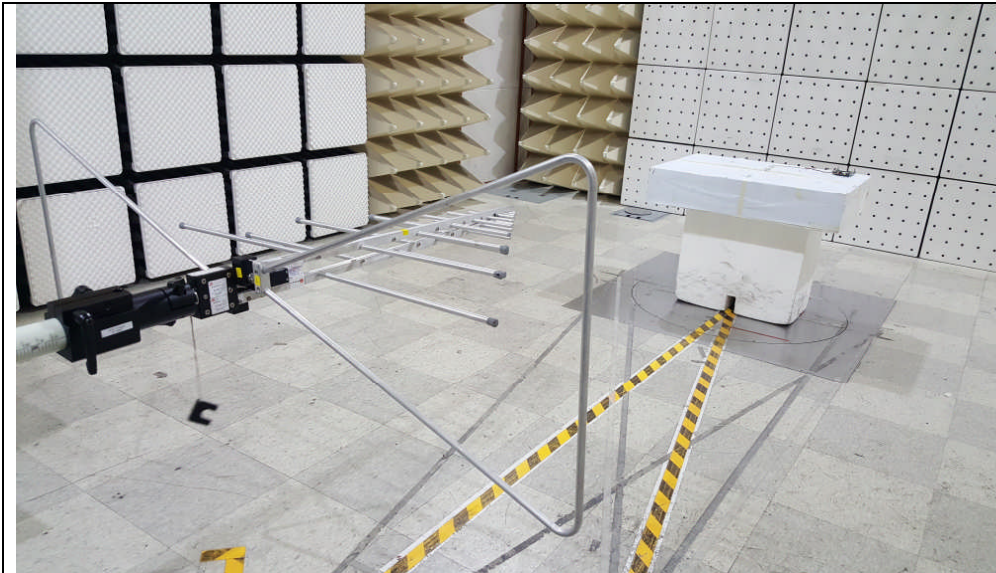
C. Z-axis



2. Worst case of orthogonal planes each frequency band

- Test setup photos for each mode were reported as representative worst axis after radiated measurements for each position were complete.
- To get a maximum emission level from the EUT, the EUT is manipulated through three orthogonal planes (X, Y, Z). Worst orthogonal plan of EUT is Y – axis during radiation test.
