Then SAR evaluation is not required.

According to 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v05 The 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances  $\leq$  50 mm are determined by: [(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW)/(min. test separation distance, mm)]  $\cdot [\sqrt{f(GHz)}] \leq 3.0$  for 1-g SAR and  $\leq$  7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR, where = f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz = f(GHz) power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation = f(GHz) The result is rounded to one decimal place for comparison Worse case is as below: [2402MHz 1.23 dBm (1.33 mW) output power] = f(GHz) =
