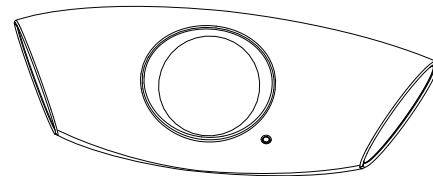

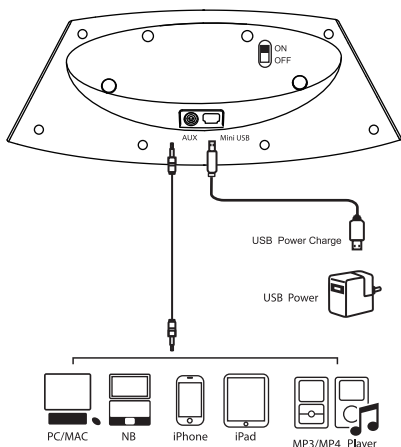

Usage Recommendations

- Please do not connect the 3.5mm audio cable and Bluetooth audio signal simultaneously.
- If they are connected simultaneously, device will first play back the music from the 3.5mm audio cable.
- If you want to play back music through Bluetooth, please remove this device's 3.5mm audio cable in order to avoid interruptions to the Bluetooth music transfer.
- Every device can only correspond to one Bluetooth music playback device at any given time; if there is a need to use different Bluetooth music playback devices, please first confirm that the connection between device and the Bluetooth music playback device not in use is disconnected in order to avoid unsuccessful music playback.

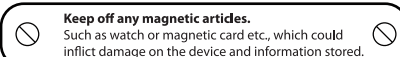
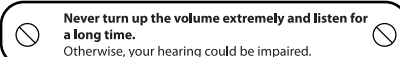
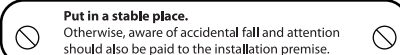
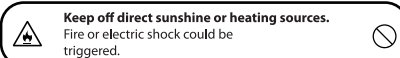
Status	Reason	Solution
Distortion or Explosive Sounds	The speaker volume turned up too much.	Turn down the volume.
No sound or Low Sound	The ON switch at the bottom of the speaker is not turned on.	Please adjust it to the ON position.
	Power is almost depleted.	Please charge it as soon as possible.
	Input Line-in is not well connected.	Check out earphone terminal is well connected with the said device input terminal.
	The notebook computer in use has insufficient power; the AC adaptor is not connected	Confirm the power status.
	The power of the connected machine equipment is not on.	Please turn on the power.
Unable to connect to the Bluetooth music playback device.	When using computer audio output, the USB and 3.5mm cable are connected simultaneously.	Please only use either the USB cable or 3.5mm cable.
	The audio device volume is minimum.	Turn up the audio device volume.
Unable to connect to the Bluetooth music playback device.	The system asked you to enter the password (but no password or the wrong password was entered).	Please set the password (the default value is 0000; it usually requires you to set it during the first connection).
	The two Bluetooth devices were not matched successfully and the connection was not set properly.	Refer to the usage steps and redo the Bluetooth device matching and connection steps.

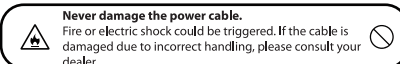
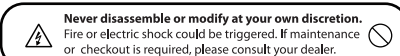
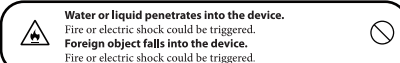

Installation and Operation

- Connect this BT device's USB cable to PC or Notebook to recharge the built-in lithium battery. The LED light is red during battery recharge.
- Switch on the speaker (ON/OFF switch is at the bottom of device). When the device is fully charged, the LED light will turn off.
- Turn on Bluetooth in your music playback device (cell phone, PC or Notebook) and it will detect this device automatically. For the first time connection, select "BT Device" on your music playback device. When this device is selected and connected successfully, you will hear a double beep sound. Then you can play back music from this device. The LED light will flash slowly. If you are asked to enter PIN code during the connecting process, please enter 0000.
- You can also connect this device to your music playback device (if it has 3.5mm headphone jack) via 3.5mm audio cable for music listening.
- When this device is fully recharged, it can continuously play back for approximately 8 hours depending on sound volume.
- Turn off this device to save power when not in use.
- When the battery is completely depleted, it takes approximately 2 hours to fully recharge it.
