



Structure of Speaker



	Component	Description
	Volume up	Short press to increase system volume. Long press to go to next track.
2	2 Multifunction	When powered off, long press for about 3~4s to power on and enter into Bluetooth mode if no AUX cable plugged in or TF card inserted. It will try to connect last paired device. If not found, it will enter into pairing mode with voice prompt.

		plugged in, double click to change modes among Bluetooth, AUX and TF card with voice prompt. With AUX cable plugged in or TF card inserted, it will automatically switch to AUX mode or TF card mode. 3. Under Bluetooth mode, short press to play/pause. With Bluetooth connected, long press for about 2 seconds to enter into pairing mode with voice prompt. 4. With coming call, short press to receive or end call. Long press to reject call. 5. To turn off, long press for about 4~5s.
3	Volume down	Short press to decrease system volume. Long press to go to last track.
4	USB jack	Charge your mobile phones through this jack. The rated output current is 1A.
5	Micro USB jack	Plug the small end of the charging cable into this jack to charge the speaker.
6	TF card jack	To insert TF card for music listening. (TF card not included)
7	AUX jack	Plug the connector from an external sound source, such as an MP3 player, into this jack.
8	Battery volumeRED LED indicator	Battery volume indicator. When batter full, four red LED on; with battery very low or empty, four red LED off. During charging, one red LED will flash indicating it's under charging status and when fully charged, all four red LED on and no flash any more. When the USB charging cable removed, the four red LED will go off after half a minute. When speaker just power on or press any button when turned on, the LED will be lit up and went out after about half a minute.
9	White LED indicator	Bluetooth reconnecting or pairing mode: white LED flash. Successful Bluetooth connection: Solid white LED. During a call: Solid white LED. AUX mode or TF card mode: Solid white LED. Speaker turned off: LED off.

Setup Instructions

Charging the speaker

- 1. Plug small end of the USB charging cable into micro USB jack at right side of the speaker. 2. Plug the other end of the USB charging cable into an available
- USB port on your computer or an USB power adaptor on wall, 3. 4pcs Red LED at right side of the speaker indicate the battery volume. When fully charged, 4pcs Red LED are all on. With very low battery or empty battery, 4pcs Red LED are all off.

Setup Instructions

Play music under Bluetooth mode

- 1. Long press multifunction button for about 3~4s to power on and enter into Bluetooth mode. The speaker will try to connect last paired device. If not found, it will enter into pairing mode with voice prompt.
- 2. Navigate to your device's Bluetooth settings, turn on Bluetooth. and then search for available devices. Select Paring Name from a list of available devices on your
- Bluetooth device. The White LED turns solid when your device is connected.
- 4. Choose the music on your device to play through the speaker.
- 5. Adjust speaker volume by short pressing the and the buttons at left side of the speaker. Long press to choose next track or last track.
- 6. Short press multifunction button to play or pause the music. 7. To disconnect from the paired Bluetooth device, turn off Bluetooth on your device or long press the multifunction button for about 2s until a voice prompt of "Disconnected".
- 8. To power off, long press multifunction button for about 4~5s. Note:
- 1) The maximum Bluetooth range is 33 feet. 2) Make sure the volume level on your Bluetooth device is at least
- 50%. 3) When speaker is turned on, it will try to connect the last paired
 - Bluetooth device automatically. If the last paired Bluetooth device is out of range, it will automatically search for another device for pairing.

Setup Instructions

Play music under AUX mode

- With the speaker turned on, plug one end of a 3.5mm stereo cable into the AUX jack on right side of the speaker. The speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode with voice prompt.
- Plug the other end of the stereo cable into your music player such as MP3, PC, CD player, mobile phones etc.
- 3. Adjust speaker volume by short pressing the and the buttons at left side of the speaker.

Setup Instructions

Play music under TF card mode

- With the speaker turned on, plug one TF card (not included) into the TF card jack. Make sure there are songs inside your TF card.
 Adjust speaker volume by short pressing the and the buttons at left side of the speaker. Long press to choose next track or last track.
- 3. Short press multifunction button to play or pause the music.

Setup Instructions

Charge to other devices

1. Plug USB A plug into the USB A jack at right side of the speaker.

- Plug the other end of the USB charging cable into your phone or other devices. (Only charging cable with micro USB jack is provided along with the speaker. If your phone or device doesn't support micro USB charging plug, please use the charging cable along with your phone or device).
- 4pcs Red LED at right side of the speaker indicate the battery volume. When fully charged, 4pcs Red LED are all on. With very low battery or empty battery, 4pcs Red LED are all off.

TROUBLESHOOTING

See below for solutions to common problems. If you have more questions to your speaker, you may contact with local distributor for assistance.

Symptom	Solution
White LED not on	Please make sure your speaker has been powered on.
Writte LED Hot off	If all four red LEDs are off, please try to charge your speaker.
	Please make sure your speaker has been powered on and charged.
Speaker does not	Make sure the volume is turned up to audible listening level for both speaker and your Bluetooth device (smart phone, pad etc).
produce sound	For Bluetooth mode, please make sure the Bluetooth is successfully connected. For TF card mode, please make sure there are songs inside. Make sure the speaker is in the right mode as desired.
	Confirm your phone/music player is Bluetooth compatible and then make sure the Bluetooth is open on your Bluetooth device.
	Make sure correct Bluetooth pairing password has been entered if required.
Bluetooth cannot be connected	During Bluetooth paring, please do not open too many Bluetooth devices to avoid interference to Bluetooth connection.
	If failed at pairing, long press multifunction button for about 2s to enter into pairing again. Or you can try to pair with another Bluetooth device.
	Clearing the pairing list on your Bluetooth device and try again.

Bluetooth connection	Make sure the distance between the speaker and your mobile phone or other Bluetooth device is within 33 feet
intermittent	As this speaker is wrapped in aluminum alloy shell, the Bluetooth antenna is at side of the speaker. Do not place obstacle at two sides of the speaker. This will interference the Bluetooth range performance.
When charge to the speaker and play music at loud volume continually, the speaker battery will be used up finally.	Charging power to the speaker is 5W while speaker rated power is 9W. Suggest not to play music while charging to the speaker.
Music in TF card can't be played	Only MP3 and WAV format of music is supported for TF card mode.
It fails to charge to my mobile phone while charging to the speaker at the same	When charging to the speaker and your mobile phone at the same time, if found no battery volume increasing to your mobile phone, unplug and then plug the mobile phone charging cable for refreshing.
time.	When charging to the speaker, the charging current to the mobile phone will be decreased.
Sound distortion	WAV and MID files are often poor quality. Therefore distortion and noise are easily noticed with powered speakers.

Check the volume level and decrease

if necessary.
