1 Plug in the Guardzilla Device.

2 Download the Guardzilla app for your smartphone.
3 Once installed, open the app to create an account or login with an existing Guardzilla account.

A Next, go to your smartphone's Settings and join the Guardzilla Wi-Fi network called Guard-XXXX.

3 Use the "Search" or the "Scan QR code" options to retrieve your device details. The device QR Code is located on the back of your Guardzilla.

6 Select your personal Wi-Fi network that you would like the Guardzilla to use.

Once Guardzilla is connected to your Wi-Fi network, click Finish to navigate back to the Guardzilla Home Screen to customize your device settings, arm your device and begin monitoring. Note password settings are default. It is recommended that you assign a secure password for your device.
