




# **BATTERY INSTALLATION**

The Chassis requires 4 AA 1.5V battery (included) and the remote requires 2 AAA 1.5V batteries (not included). Use a Phillips head or Cross screwdriver to loosen the screw securing the corresponding battery cover plate. Insert the batterie(s), ensuring the correct polarity per the diagrams. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw.










2. Customize the Chassis with the included accessories or use your favorite blocks
