The transmitter module itself has not changed. The antenna and rated power have also not changed. Here are the changes:

Updated the User Manual to include installation instructions so that the module can be installed in Stryker devices by third parties.

KDB 996369 D01 allows modules to be end-user plug-and-play replaceable as long as any control that will cause operation of the device in violation of the regulations is not provided. The module is designed to interface with Stryker products using a proprietary connector and the firmware drivers to enable the module are embedded into the host such that the installer and the end user cannot change the operation of the module.
