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

#### 3.6.6 Emissions in Restricted Frequency Bands (Below 30MHz)

There is a comparison data of both open-field test site and alternative test site - semi-Anechoic chamber according to KDB414788 Radiated Test Site, and the result came out very similar.

All amplitude of spurious emissions that are attenuated by more than 20 dB below the permissible value has no need to be reported.

The radiated emissions were investigated from 9 kHz or the lowest frequency generated within the device, up to the 10th harmonic or 40 GHz, whichever is appropriate.
