## E-Mail to End User Device Manufacturers -

**Reference Line** – Modification of End User Equipment Authorization to Reflect Supplemental Coverage from Space Capability

Dear [Manufacturer]

We are requesting that you act as soon as possible to update device certifications to include Part 25 in order to facilitate our planned direct-to-cell satellite service.

In March 2024, the FCC adopted rules allowing satellite operators to provide supplemental coverage from space ("SCS") using some spectrum bands otherwise already designated for terrestrial networks. The FCC recognized that the devices consumers will use are the same devices that operate on today's terrestrial networks and that they will not be modified in order to work on satellite networks. Accordingly, the FCC established a temporary waiver procedure, *which is now in effect for a limited time*, that allows device manufacturers to add a Part 25 (satellite) SCS designation to equipment certifications that were issued *before June 29, 2024*, and already authorize use of the following bands:

- 600 MHz: 614-652 MHz and 663-698 MHz
- 700 MHz: 698-769 MHz, 775-799 MHz, and 805-806 MHz
- 800 MHz: 824-849 MHz and 869-894 MHz
- Broadband PCS: 1850-1915 MHz and 1930-1995 MHz
- AWS-H Block: 1915-1920 MHz and 1995-2000 MHz

In order for end user device manufacturers with already authorized equipment in these bands to take advantage of this temporary waiver, they must submit an FCC Form 731 Class II permission change. The FCC also requires a cover letter and a Certification attachment to the FCC Form 731. A sample of each is attached. The FCC instructs that authorization holders should not mark the "associated with a waiver" box on the FCC Form 731 or adhere to the usual waiver requirements outlined in KDB 502150. Also, the Pre-Approval Guidance procedures are not required.
