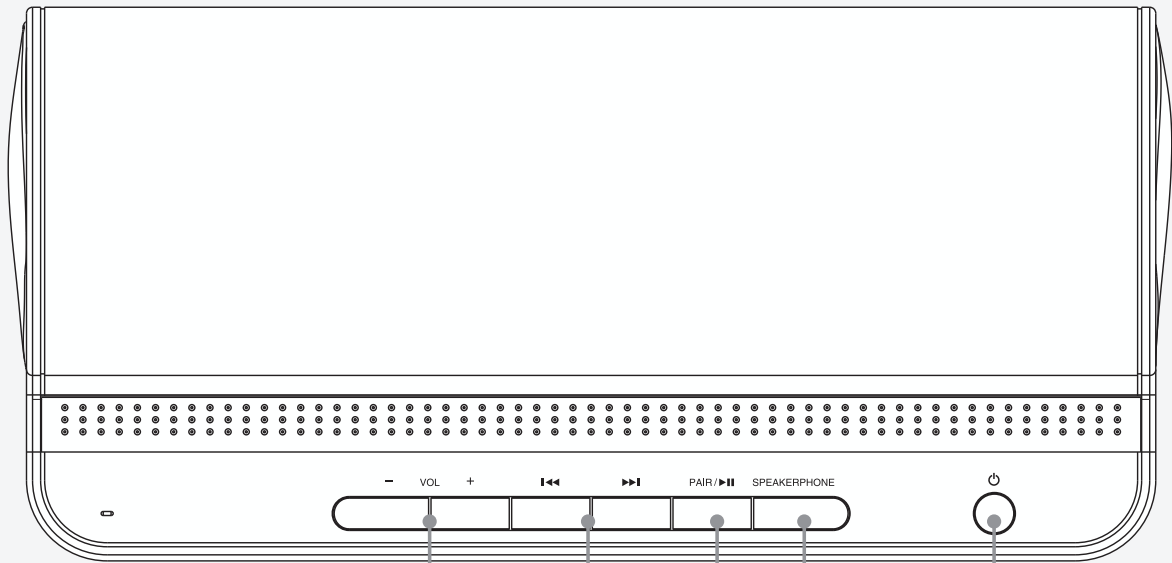

Volume
