This has been verified and satisfied with KDB 784748 D01 Labeling Part 15 & 18 Guidelines as stated below:

The device is handheld.

The FCC ID label will be added inside the battery compartment. The device is marketed without the battery installed, so the user must open the battery compartment in order to install the battery and will find the FCC ID label inside the battery compartment when they install the battery.

No special tools are required in order to obtain access to the FCC label information located inside the battery compartment. The location of the label is not on a removable part.
