

1.1 Scope

Measurement and determination of electromagnetic emissions (EME) of radio frequency devices including intentional and/or unintentional radiators for compliance with the technical rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission and the Industry Canada Certification and Engineering Bureau.

1.2 **Testing Facility**




Figure 1-1. Map of the Greater Baltimore and Metropolitan Washington, D.C. area

The map below shows the location of the PCTEST LABORATORY, its proximity to the FCC Laboratory, the Columbia vicinity, the Baltimore-Washington Internt'I (BWI) airport, the city of Baltimore and the Washington, DC area. (See Figure 1-1).

These measurement tests were conducted at the PCTEST Engineering Laboratory, Inc. facility located at 7185 Oakland Mills Road, Columbia, MD 21046. The site coordinates are 39° 10'23" N latitude and 76° 49'50" W longitude. The facility is 0.4 miles North of the FCC laboratory, and the ambient signal and ambient signal strength are approximately equal to those of the FCC laboratory. The detailed description of the measurement facility was found to be in compliance with the requirements of § 2.948 according to ANSI C63.4-2014 on January 22, 2015.

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





Radiated Measurements §2.1053 §22.913(a.2) §22.917(a) §24.232(c) §24.238(a)

The radiated test facilities consisted of an indoor 3 meter semi-anechoic chamber used for final measurements and exploratory measurements, when necessary. The measurement area is contained within the semi-anechoic chamber which is shielded from any ambient interference. The test site inside the chamber is a 6m x 5.2m elliptical, obstruction-free area in accordance with Clause 5, Figure 5.7 of ANSI C63.4-2009. For measurements above 1GHz absorbers are arranged on the floor between the turn table and the antenna mast in such a way so as to maximize the reduction of reflections. For measurements below 1GHz, the absorbers are removed. An ETS Lindgren Model 2188 raised turntable is used for radiated measurement. It is a continuously rotatable, remote-controlled, metallic turntable and 2 meters (6.56 ft.) in diameter. The turn table is flush with the raised floor of the chamber in order to maintain its function as a ground plane. A 78cm high PVC support structure is placed on top of the turntable. A 3/4" (~1.9cm) sheet of high density polyethylene is used as the table top and is placed on top of the PVC supports to bring the total height of the table to 80cm.

The equipment under test was transmitting while connected to its integral antenna and is placed on a turntable 3 meters from the receive antenna. The receive antenna height is adjusted between 1 and 4 meter height, the turntable is rotated through 360 degrees, and the EUT is manipulated through all orthogonal planes representative of its typical use to achieve the highest reading on the receive spectrum analyzer.

Per the guidance of ANSI/TIA-603-C-2004, a half-wave dipole is then substituted in place of the EUT. For emissions above 1GHz, a horn antenna is substituted in place of the EUT. The substitute antenna is driven by a signal generator with the level of the signal generator being adjusted to obtain the same receive spectrum analyzer level previously recorded from the spurious emission from the EUT. The power of the emission is calculated using the following formula:

Where, P_d is the dipole equivalent power, P_d is the generator output into the substitution antenna, and the antenna gain is the gain of the substitute antenna used relative to either a half-wave dipole (dBd) or an isotropic source (dBi). The substitute level is equal to Pq [dBm] - cable loss [dB].

Radiated power levels are investigated with the receive antenna vertically polarized while radiated spurious emissions levels are investigated with the receive antenna horizontally and vertically polarized per ANSI/TIA-603-C-2004.

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MEASUREMENT UNCERTAINTY

The measurement uncertainties shown below were calculated in accordance with the requirements of ANSI C63.4-2014. All measurement uncertainty values are shown with a coverage factor of k = 2 to indicate a 95% level of confidence. The measurement data shown herein meets or exceeds the U_{CISPR} measurement uncertainty values specified in CISPR 16-4-2 and, thus, can be compared directly to specified limits to determine compliance.

Spurious Radiated Emission

Example: Spurious emission at 3700.40 MHz

The receive spectrum analyzer reading at 3 meters with the EUT on the turntable was -81.0 dBm. The gain of the substituted antenna is 8.1 dBi. The signal generator connected to the substituted antenna terminals is adjusted to produce a reading of -81.0 dBm on the spectrum analyzer. The loss of the cable between the signal generator and the terminals of the substituted antenna is 2.0 dB at 3700.40 MHz. So 6.1 dB is added to the signal generator reading of -30.9 dBm yielding -24.80 dBm. The fundamental EIRP was 25.50 dBm so this harmonic was 25.50 dBm - (-24.80) = 50.3 dBc.

Notes:

- 1) All modes of operation and data rates were investigated. The test results shown in the following sections represent the worst case emissions.
- 2) The analyzer plots were all taken with a correction table loaded into the analyzer. The correction table was used to account for the losses of the cables, directional couplers, and attenuators used as part of the system to maintain a link between the call box and the EUT at all frequencies of interest.
- 3) All antenna port conducted emissions testing was performed on a test bench with the antenna port of the EUT connected to the spectrum analyzer through calibrated cables, attenuators, and couplers.
- 4) For conducted spurious emissions, automated test software was used to measure emissions and capture the corresponding plots necessary to show compliance. The measurement software utilized is PCTEST "2G/3G Automation," Version 3.2.

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7.2 Occupied Bandwidth §2.1049

Test Overview

The occupied bandwidth, that is the frequency bandwidth such that, below its lower and above its upper frequency limits, the mean powers radiated are each equal to 0.5 percent of the total mean power radiated by a given emission shall be measured. All modes of operation were investigated and the worst case configuration results are reported in this section.

Test Procedure Used

KDB 971168 D01 v02r02 - Section 4.2

Test Settings

- 1. The signal analyzer's automatic bandwidth measurement capability was used to perform the 99% occupied bandwidth and the 26dB bandwidth. The bandwidth measurement was not influenced by any intermediate power nulls in the fundamental emission.
- 2. RBW = 1 5% of the expected OBW
- 3. VBW \geq 3 x RBW
- 4. Detector = Peak
- 5. Trace mode = max hold
- 6. Sweep = auto couple
- 7. The trace was allowed to stabilize
- 8. If necessary, steps 2-7 were repeated after changing the RBW such that it would be within 1-5% of the 99% occupied bandwidth observed in Step 7




Figure 7-1. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup



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Spurious and Harmonic Emissions at Antenna Terminal 7.3 §2.1051 §22.917(a) §24.238(a)

Test Overview

The level of the carrier and the various conducted spurious and harmonic frequencies is measured by means of a calibrated spectrum analyzer. The spectrum is scanned from the lowest frequency generated in the equipment up to a frequency including its 10th harmonic. All out of band emissions are measured with a spectrum analyzer connected to the antenna terminal of the EUT while the EUT is operating at maximum power, and at the appropriate frequencies. All data rates were investigated to determine the worst case configuration. All modes of operation were investigated and the worst case configuration results are reported in this section.

The minimum permissible attenuation level of any spurious emission is 43 + $log_{10}(P_{(Watts)})$, where P is the transmitter power in Watts.

Test Procedure Used

KDB 971168 D01 v02r02 - Section 6.0

Test Settings

- 1. Start frequency was set to 30MHz and stop frequency was set to 10GHz for Cell, 20GHz for PCS (separated into at least two plots per channel)
- 2. Detector = RMS
- 3. Trace mode = trace average for continuous emissions, max hold for pulse emissions
- 4. Sweep time = auto couple
- 5. The trace was allowed to stabilize
- 6. Please see test notes below for RBW and VBW settings





Figure 7-2. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup


Compliance with the applicable limits is based on the use of measurement instrumentation employing a resolution bandwidth of 100 kHz or greater for Part 22 and 1 MHz or greater for Part 24. However, in the 1 MHz bands immediately outside and adjacent to the frequency block a resolution bandwidth of at least one percent of the emission bandwidth of the fundamental emission of the transmitter may be employed. The emission bandwidth is defined as the width of the signal between two points, one below the carrier center frequency and one above the carrier center frequency, outside of which all emission are attenuated at least 26 dB below the transmitter power.

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Plot 7-7. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 128)




Plot 7-8. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 128)

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
Plot 7-9. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 128)




Plot 7-10. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 190)

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
Plot 7-11. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 190)




Plot 7-12. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 190)

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
Plot 7-13. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 251)




Plot 7-14. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 251)

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Plot 7-15. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 251)




Plot 7-16. Conducted Spurious Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 512)

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
Plot 7-17. Conducted Spurious Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 512)




Plot 7-18. Conducted Spurious Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 512)

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
Plot 7-19. Conducted Spurious Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 661)




Plot 7-20. Conducted Spurious Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 661)

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
Plot 7-21. Conducted Spurious Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 661)

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
Plot 7-23. Conducted Spurious Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 810)





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Plot 7-25. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular WCDMA Mode - Ch. 4132)





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
Plot 7-27. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular WCDMA Mode – Ch. 4132)

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
Plot 7-29. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular WCDMA Mode - Ch. 4183)




Plot 7-30. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular WCDMA Mode - Ch. 4183)

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Plot 7-31. Conducted Spurious Plot (Cellular WCDMA Mode - Ch. 4233)









Figure 7-3. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup



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
Plot 7-43. Band Edge Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 128)




Plot 7-44. Band Edge Plot (Cellular GPRS Mode - Ch. 251)

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
Plot 7-45. Band Edge Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 512)




Plot 7-46. 4MHz Span Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 512)







Figure 7-4. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup



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
Plot 7-55. Peak-Average Ratio Plot (PCS GPRS Mode - Ch. 661)




Figure 7-5. Radiated Test Setup <1GHz




Figure 7-6. Radiated Test Setup >1GHz




Figure 7-7. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

Test Overview and Limit

Frequency stability testing is performed in accordance with the guidelines of ANSI/TIA-603-C-2004. The frequency stability of the transmitter is measured by:

- Temperature: The temperature is varied from -30°C to +50°C in 10°C increments using an a.) environmental chamber.
- b.) Primary Supply Voltage: The primary supply voltage is varied from 85% to 115% of the nominal value for non hand-carried battery and AC powered equipment. For hand-carried, battery-powered equipment, primary supply voltage is reduced to the battery operating end point which shall be specified by the manufacturer.

For Part 22, the frequency stability of the transmitter shall be maintained within ±0.00025% (±2.5 ppm) of the center frequency. For Part 24, the frequency stability shall be sufficient to ensure that the fundamental emission stays within the authorized frequency block.

Test Procedure Used

ANSI/TIA-603-C-2004

Test Settings

- 1. The carrier frequency of the transmitter is measured at room temperature (20°C to provide a reference).
- 2. The equipment is turned on in a "standby" condition for fifteen minutes before applying power to the transmitter. Measurement of the carrier frequency of the transmitter is made within one minute after applying power to the transmitter.
- 3. Frequency measurements are made at 10°C intervals ranging from -30°C to +50°C. A period of at least one half-hour is provided to allow stabilization of the equipment at each temperature level.

The EUT was connected via an RF cable to a spectrum analyzer with the EUT placed inside an environmental chamber.




Figure 7-8. Frequency Stability Graph (Cellular GSM Mode – Ch. 190)




Figure 7-9. Frequency Stability Graph (Cellular WCDMA Mode – Ch. 4183)

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


Figure 7-10. Frequency Stability Graph (PCS GSM Mode - Ch. 661)




Figure 7-11. Frequency Stability Graph (PCS WCDMA Mode – Ch. 9400)
