



#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 Scope

Measurement and determination of electromagnetic emissions (EME) of radio frequency devices including intentional and/or unintentional radiators for compliance with the technical rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission and the Industry Canada Certification and Engineering Bureau.

### 1.2 Testing Facility




Figure 1-1. Map of the Greater Baltimore and Metropolitan Washington, D.C. area

The map below shows the location of the PCTEST LABORATORY, its proximity to the FCC Laboratory, the Columbia vicinity, the Baltimore-Washington Internt'I (BWI) airport, the city of Baltimore and the Washington, DC area. (See Figure 1-1).

These measurement tests were conducted at the PCTEST Engineering Laboratory, Inc. facility located at 7185 Oakland Mills Road, Columbia, MD 21046. The site coordinates are 39° 10'23" N latitude and 76° 49'50" W longitude. The facility is 0.4 miles North of the FCC laboratory, and the ambient signal and ambient signal strength are approximately equal to those of the FCC laboratory. The detailed description of the measurement facility was found to be in compliance with the requirements of § 2.948 according to ANSI C63.4-2014 on January 22, 2015.

## 2.0 PRODUCT INFORMATION

## 2.1 Equipment Description

The Equipment Under Test (EUT) is the **LG Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFLS993**. The test data contained in this report pertains only to the emissions due to the EUT's licensed transmitters that operate under the provisions of Part 22(H) and 90.691.

## 2.2 Device Capabilities

This device contains the following capabilities:

850/1900 CDMA/EVDO Rev0/A (BC0, BC1, BC10), 850/1900 GSM/GPRS/EDGE, 850/1700/1900 WCDMA, Multi-band LTE, 802.11b/g/n WLAN, 802.11a/n/ac UNII, Bluetooth (1x, EDR, LE), NFC

### 2.3 Test Configuration

The EUT was tested per the guidance of ANSI/TIA-603-D-2010 and KDB 971168 D01 v02r02. See Section 7.0 of this test report for a description of the radiated and antenna port conducted emissions tests.

This device supports wireless charging capability and, thus, is subject to the test requirements of KDB 648474 D03 v01r04. Additional radiated spurious emission measurements were performed with the EUT lying flat on a certified wireless charging pad (WCP) while operating under normal conditions in a simulated call or data transmission configuration. The worst case radiated emissions data is shown in this report.

## 2.4 EMI Suppression Device(s)/Modifications

No EMI suppression device(s) were added and no modifications were made during testing.

#### 3.0 DESCRIPTION OF TESTS

#### 3.1 Evaluation Procedure

The measurement procedures described in the document titled "Land Mobile FM or PM – Communications Equipment – Measurements and Performance Standards" (ANSI/TIA-603-D-2010) and "Procedures for Compliance Measurement of the Fundamental Emission Power of Licensed Wideband (> 1 MHz) Digital Transmission Systems" (KDB 971168 D01 v02r02) were used in the measurement of the EUT.

## 3.2 Occupied Bandwidth §2.1049

The occupied bandwidth, that is the frequency bandwidth such that, below its lower and above its upper frequency limits, the mean powers radiated are each equal to 0.5 percent of the total mean power radiated by a given emission shall be measured. The spectrum analyzers' "occupied bandwidth" measurement function was used to record the occupied bandwidth in accordance with KDB 971168 D01 v02r02.

## 3.3 Spurious and Harmonic Emissions at Antenna Terminal §2.1051, §90.691

The level of the carrier and the various conducted spurious and harmonic frequencies is measured by means of a calibrated spectrum analyzer. The spectrum is scanned from the lowest frequency generated in the equipment up to a frequency including its 10<sup>th</sup> harmonic.

Out-of-band emission requirement shall apply only to the "outer" channels included in an EA license and to spectrum adjacent to interior channels used by incumbent licensees. The emission limits are as follows:

For any frequency removed from the EA licensee's frequency block by up to and including 37.5 kHz, the power of any emission shall be attenuated below the transmitter power (P) in watts by at least 116  $\log_{10}(f/6.1)$  decibels or 50 + 10  $\log_{10}(P)$  decibels or 80 decibels, whichever is the lesser attenuation, where f is the frequency removed from the center of the outer channel in the block in kilohertz and where f is greater than 12.5 kHz.

For any frequency removed from the EA licensee's frequency block greater than 37.5 kHz, the power of any emission shall be attenuated below the transmitter power (P) in watts by at least 43 +  $10Log_{10}(P)$  decibels or 80 decibels, whichever is the lesser attenuation, where f is the frequency removed from the center of the outer channel in the block in kilohertz and where f is greater than 37.5 kHz.

### Radiated Power and Radiated Spurious Emissions §2.1053, §90.635, §90.691

The radiated test facilities consisted of an indoor 3 meter semi-anechoic chamber used for final measurements and exploratory measurements, when necessary. The measurement area is contained within the semi-anechoic chamber which is shielded from any ambient interference. The test site inside the chamber is a 6m x 5.2m elliptical, obstruction-free area in accordance with Figure 5.7 of Clause 5 in ANSI C63.4-2014. Absorbers are arranged on the floor between the turn table and the antenna mast in such a way so as to maximize the reduction of reflections for measurements above 1GHz. For measurements below 1GHz, the absorbers are removed. A raised turntable is used for radiated measurement. The turn table is a continuously rotatable, remote-controlled, metallic turntable and 2 meters (6.56 ft.) in diameter. The turn table is flush with the raised floor of the chamber in order to maintain its function as a ground plane. A 72.4cm high PVC support structure is placed on top of the turntable. A 3" (~7.6cm) sheet of high density polystyrene is used as the table top and is placed on top of the PVC supports to bring the total height of the table to 80cm.

The equipment under test was transmitting while connected to its integral antenna and is placed on a wooden turntable 80cm above the ground plane and 3 meters from the receive antenna. The receive antenna height is adjusted between 1 and 4 meter height, the turntable is rotated through 360 degrees, and the EUT is manipulated through all orthogonal planes representative of its typical use to achieve the highest reading on the receive spectrum analyzer. Radiated power levels are also investigated with the receive antenna horizontally and vertically polarized. The maximized power level is recorded using the spectrum analyzer "Channel Power" function with the integration band set to the emissions' occupied bandwidth, a RMS detector, RBW = 100kHz, VBW = 300kHz, and a 1 second sweep time over a minimum of 10 sweeps, per the guidelines of KDB 971168 D01 v02r02.

Per the guidance of ANSI/TIA-603-D-2010, a half-wave dipole is then substituted in place of the EUT. For emissions above 1GHz, a horn antenna is substituted in place of the EUT. The substitute antenna is driven by a signal generator with the level of the signal generator being adjusted to obtain the same receive spectrum analyzer level previously recorded from the spurious emission from the EUT. The power of the emission is calculated using the following formula:

$$P_{d [dBm]} = P_{g [dBm]} - cable loss_{[dB]} + antenna gain_{[dBd/dBi]}$$

Where,  $P_d$  is the dipole equivalent power,  $P_d$  is the generator output into the substitution antenna, and the antenna gain is the gain of the substitute antenna used relative to either a half-wave dipole (dBd) or an isotropic source (dBi). The substitute level is equal to Pg [dBm] - cable loss [dB].

The calculated Pd levels are then compared to the absolute spurious emission limit of -13dBm which is equivalent to the required minimum attenuation of 43 + 10log<sub>10</sub>(Power [Watts]) specified in 90.691.

For fundamental radiated power measurements, the guidance of KDB 971168 D01 v02r02 is used to record the EUT power level that is subsequently matched via the aforementioned substitution method given in ANSI/TIA-603-D-2010.

Frequency stability testing is performed in accordance with the guidelines of ANSI/TIA-603-D-2010. The frequency stability of the transmitter is measured by:

- a.) **Temperature:** The temperature is varied from -30°C to +50°C in 10°C increments using an environmental chamber.
- b.) **Primary Supply Voltage:** The primary supply voltage is varied from 85% to 115% of the nominal value for non hand-carried battery and AC powered equipment. For hand-carried, battery-powered equipment, primary supply voltage is reduced to the battery operating end point which shall be specified by the manufacturer.

Specification – For Part 90.213, the frequency stability of the transmitter shall be maintained within  $\pm 0.00025\%$  ( $\pm 2.5$  ppm) of the center frequency.

#### **Time Period and Procedure:**

- 1. The carrier frequency of the transmitter is measured at room temperature (20°C to provide a reference).
- 2. The equipment is turned on in a "standby" condition for fifteen minutes before applying power to the transmitter. Measurement of the carrier frequency of the transmitter is made within one minute after applying power to the transmitter.
- 3. Frequency measurements are made at 10°C intervals ranging from -30°C to +50°C. A sufficient stabilization period at each temperature shall be used prior to each frequency requirement.

### <u>Spurious Radiated Emission – BC10</u>

Example: Channel 476 CDMA BC10 Mode 3<sup>rd</sup> Harmonic (2453.70MHz)

The average spectrum analyzer reading at 3 meters with the EUT on the turntable was -81.0 dBm. The gain of the substituted antenna is 8.1 dBi. The signal generator connected to the substituted antenna terminals is adjusted to produce a reading of -81.0 dBm on the spectrum analyzer. The loss of the cable between the signal generator and the terminals of the substituted antenna is 2.0 dB at 2453.70 MHz. So 6.1 dB is added to the signal generator reading of -30.9 dBm yielding -24.80 dBm. The fundamental EIRP was 25.501 dBm so this harmonic was 25.501 dBm - (-24.80) = 50.3 dBc.

**Example: Middle Channel LTE Mode 2<sup>nd</sup> Harmonic (1564 MHz)** 

The average spectrum analyzer reading at 3 meters with the EUT on the turntable was -81.0 dBm. The gain of the substituted antenna is 8.1 dBi. The signal generator connected to the substituted antenna terminals is adjusted to produce a reading of -81.0 dBm on the spectrum analyzer. The loss of the cable between the signal generator and the terminals of the substituted antenna is 2.0 dB at 1564 MHz. So 6.1 dB is added to the signal generator reading of -30.9 dBm yielding -24.80 dBm. The fundamental EIRP was 25.501 dBm so this harmonic was 25.501 dBm - (-24.80).





Figure 7-1. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup


Plot 7-1. Occupied Bandwidth Plot CDMA (Ch. 476)




Plot 7-2. Occupied Bandwidth Plot CDMA (Ch. 684)

Plot 7-7. Occupied Bandwidth Plot LTE B26 (3MHz 16-QAM - RB Size 15- Low Channel)




Plot 7-8. Occupied Bandwidth Plot LTE B26 (3MHz 64-QAM – RB Size 15– Low Channel)


Plot 7-13. Occupied Bandwidth Plot LTE B26 (10MHz 16-QAM - RB Size 50)




Plot 7-14. Occupied Bandwidth Plot LTE B26 (10MHz 64-QAM - RB Size 50)


Plot 7-15. Occupied Bandwidth Plot LTE B26 (15MHz QPSK - RB Size 75)





Figure 7-2. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup




Plot 7-18. Conducted Spurious Plot LTE B26 CDMA (Ch. 476)




Plot 7-19. Conducted Spurious Plot LTE B26 CDMA (Ch. 476)


Plot 7-20. Conducted Spurious Plot LTE B26 CDMA (Ch. 684)




Plot 7-21. Conducted Spurious Plot LTE B26 CDMA (Ch. 684)




Plot 7-23. Conducted Spurious Plot LTE B26 (5MHz QPSK - RB Size 1, RB Offset 0 - Low Channel)




Figure 7-3. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup




Plot 7-26. Channel Edge Plot CDMA (Ch. 476)




Plot 7-27. Channel Edge Plot CDMA (Ch. 684)


Plot 7-28. Channel Edge Plot LTE B26 (1.4MHz QPSK - RB Size 6- Low Channel)

Plot 7-30. Channel Edge Plot LTE B26 (3MHz QPSK - RB Size 15- Low Channel)




Plot 7-31. Channel Edge Plot LTE B26 (3MHz QPSK - RB Size 15 - High Channel)

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
Plot 7-32. Channel Edge Plot LTE B26 (5MHz QPSK - RB Size 25- Low Channel)




Plot 7-33. Channel Edge Plot LTE B26 (5MHz QPSK - RB Size 25 - High Channel)




Figure 7-4. Radiated Test Setup <1GHz

#### **Test Overview**

Radiated spurious emissions measurements are performed using the substitution method described in ANSI/TIA-603-D-2010 with the EUT transmitting into an integral antenna. Measurements on signals operating below 1GHz are performed using horizontally and vertically polarized tuned dipole antennas. Measurements on signals operating above 1GHz are performed using vertically and horizontally polarized broadband horn antennas. 


Figure 7-5. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

#### **Test Overview and Limit**

Frequency stability testing is performed in accordance with the guidelines of ANSI/TIA-603-D-2010. The frequency stability of the transmitter is measured by:

- a.) **Temperature:** The temperature is varied from -30°C to +50°C in 10°C increments using an environmental chamber.
- b.) **Primary Supply Voltage:** The primary supply voltage is varied from 85% to 115% of the nominal value for non hand-carried battery and AC powered equipment. For hand-carried, battery-powered equipment, primary supply voltage is reduced to the battery operating end point which shall be specified by the manufacturer.

The frequency stability of the transmitter shall be maintained within  $\pm 0.00025\%$  ( $\pm 2.5$  ppm) of the center frequency.

#### **Test Settings**

- 1. The carrier frequency of the transmitter is measured at room temperature (20°C to provide a reference).
- 2. The equipment is turned on in a "standby" condition for fifteen minutes before applying power to the transmitter. Measurement of the carrier frequency of the transmitter is made within one minute after applying power to the transmitter.
- 3. Frequency measurements are made at 10°C intervals ranging from -30°C to +50°C. A period of at least one half-hour is provided to allow stabilization of the equipment at each temperature level.




Figure 7-6. CDMA BC10 Frequency Stability Graph (Ch. 476)


