

1/14 Scale R/C Car Instruction Manual

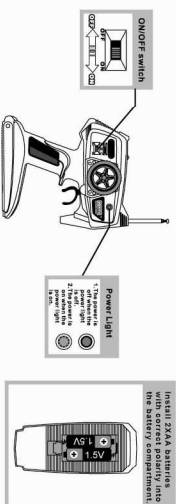
Thank you for purchasing this remote control toy car. In order to gain a thorough understanding of the product and safe, trouble-free operation, please read the following instructions carefully before use.

SPECIFICATIONS AND FEATURES

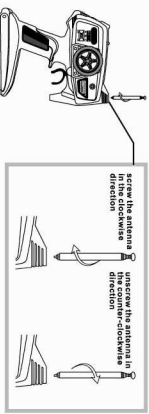
This R/C car has 5 functions: forward, backward, right & left steering and stop. It requires 2xAA batteries and 1x4.8V rechargeable battery for the remote control and R/C car respectively. Battery charging time is about 4-6 hours. A fully charged battery can support the car for about 25 minutes. To give full play to the car's performance, please make sure that battery is full charged before playing.

HOW TO INSTALL THE BATTERY, ANTENNA AND CHARGING THE BATTERY:

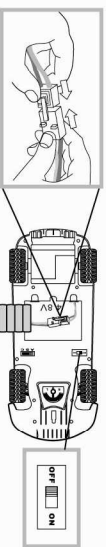
1. Install the batteries into remote control: Open the battery compartment cover, insert 2xAA batteries into the battery compartment. Ensure that the battery is inserted properly by matching the "+" and "-" symbols indicating inside the battery compartment. Close the compartment cover. Turn the power switch to "ON". The red power light will turn on, indicating that power is now supplied to the remote control.



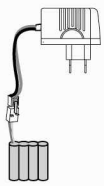
2. Insert the antenna into the small hole located at the top of the remote control unit; screw it until it is well tightened by turning it in the clockwise direction. You can unscrew and remove it by turning it in counter-clockwise direction.



3. Remote control car: Open the battery compartment cover located at the bottom of the car. Connect the plug of the battery cable to the power port of the car (matching the plug to the port); Insert the battery pack into the battery compartment of the car and close the compartment cover. Turn the power switch to "ON" to power the car on.



4. Charging the battery:
1. Rechargeable battery is only to be charged under adult supervision.
 2. Rechargeable battery is to be removed from the toy before being charged.
 3. Insert the plug of the battery cable into the port of the battery charger (matching the plug to the port). Then, connect the plug of the battery charger to AC power outlet. Afterwards, the battery charging starts.
 4. Full charging takes about 4-6 hours. (It is not advisable to charge the battery for an excessive length of time).
 5. Before using the charged battery after charging, first unplug the battery charger from the power outlet and then press lightly on the rear part of the battery charger to release it from the ports.
 6. Please keep regular inspection on the charger cable, the plug, the body of the car and other accessories. If damages are found, please stop playing until it is well repaired.



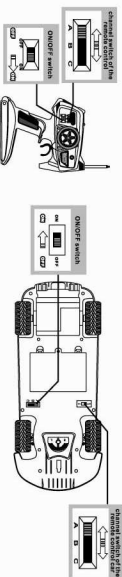

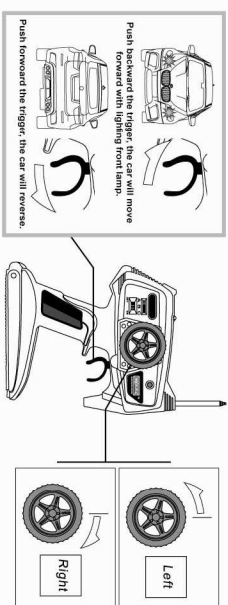

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

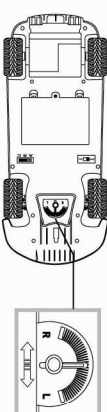
1. Turn the power switch of the remote control car and the remote control unit to the "ON" position. Switch the channel control on both the remote control and the model car to the same channel.



2. Operate the gun style remote control unit: When the trigger is pulled back half way, the remote control car will move forward at a low speed; When the trigger is pulled back fully, the remote control car will move forward at a high speed. When the trigger is pushed forward, the remote control car will reverse. When the direction steering wheel of the remote control unit is turned clockwise, the remote control car will steer to the right and when it is turned anti-clockwise, the car will steer to the left (the correct operation method is to hold the remote control unit with the left hand and use the fingers of the left hand to operate the trigger; use the right hand to operate the steering wheel).



3. If the remote control car fails to run in a straight line, adjust the direction adjustment rod on the bottom of the car by turning it slightly to the right/left until the straightest position is achieved.



4. When the antenna is pulled out to a certain length, the remote control operating distance of the remote control car will be increased accordingly.

5. When the remote control car is not in use, please switch off the power on both the remote control unit and the remote control car.

WARNINGS

- Do not attempt to charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity direction.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard/carbon zinc, or rechargeable (nickel cadmium) batteries.
- Please take out batteries when not in use.
- The toy must only be used with the recommended transformer.
- The transformer is not a toy.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

SPECIAL WARNINGS TO PARENTS

Parents should regularly examine this toy for potential hazards such as damage to cables or cords, plugs and enclosures. If any damage is detected the toy should not be used until it has been repaired by a professional.
