
4 Installation

- 2. In case of missing parts or external damages, please contact your local dealer for replacement.


Please keep the original package for shipping in case of warranty case.


- 3. Take care to shut down all devices first.

- 6. If all cables are connected you can start the computers. The installation is complete.



5 Use

You can control the KVM by using the switches at the front or by using Hot-Keys.

1. Toggle by switches

The switches at the front of the device are control buttons as well as LED indicators.

You can switch between the computers by pushing the buttons. The right LEDs show the selected port. The left LEDs show the online status of these ports.

2. Toggle by Hot Keys

Fast 2x pushing of the left Strg-button = Toggles one up

Fast 2x pushing of the right Strg-button = Toggles one down

Pushing "Scroll Lock" twice and "Enter" starts an automatic run. It will step forward once every 5 seconds. You stop that run by pushing the Space bar.
