

Installing the battery

# 1. Open the battery cover of the headphones and transmitter. Wireless Transmitter



- Insert two (2) AAA alkaline batteries (not included) with the (+) and (-) poles correctly aligned into the battery compartments of the headphones and transmitter.
- 3. Close the battery covers.





### Connecting to a television




