GENERAL INFORMATION

Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The *b* mobile HK Limited's product, model number: K350 (FCC ID: ZSW-10-003) or the "EUT" in this report was a *Mobile Phone*, which was measured approximately: 112 mm (L) \times 58 mm (W) \times 14 mm (H), rated input voltage: DC 3.7 V battery or DC 5.0V from adapter.

Objective

This test report is prepared on behalf of *b mobile HK Limited* in accordance with Part 2-Subpart J, Part 22-Subpart H, Part 24-Subpart E of the Federal Communication Commissions rules.

The objective is to determine the compliance of the EUT with FCC rules for output power, modulation characteristic, occupied bandwidth, and spurious emission at antenna terminal, spurious radiated emission, frequency stability and band edge.

Test Methodology

All tests and measurements indicated in this document were performed in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations Title 47 Part 2-Subpart J as well as the following parts:

Part 22 Subpart H - Public Mobile Services Part 24 Subpart E - Personal Communication Services

Applicable Standards: TIA-1037, TIA/EIA 603-D & ANSI C63.4-2009.

All radiated and conducted emissions measurements were performed at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. The radiated testing was performed at an antenna-to-EUT distance of 3 meters.

Measurement uncertainty with radiated emission is 5.91 dB for 30MHz-1GHz.and 4.92 dB for above 1GHz, 1.95dB for conducted measurement.

Test Facility

The test site used by Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp.(Shenzhen) to collect test data is located on the 6/F, the 3rd Phase of WanLi Industrial Building, ShiHua Road, FuTian Free Trade Zone Shenzhen, Guangdong, China.

Test site at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Shenzhen) has been fully described in reports submitted to the Federal Communication Commission (FCC). 





The RF output of the transceiver was connected to a spectrum analyzer and simulator through appropriate attenuation. The resolution bandwidth of the spectrum analyzer was set at 1MHz. Sufficient scans were taken to show any out of band emissions up to 10th harmonic.

Test Procedure

The transmitter was placed on a wooden turntable, and it was transmitting into a non-radiating load which was also placed on the turntable.

The measurement antenna was placed at a distance of 3 meters from the EUT. During the tests, the receiving antenna height and polarization as well as EUT azimuth were varied in order to identify the maximum level of emissions from the EUT. The test was performed by placing the EUT on 3-orthogonal axis.

The frequency range up to tenth harmonic of the fundamental frequency was investigated.

Remove the EUT and replace it with substitution antenna. A signal generator was connected to the substitution antenna by a non-radiating cable. The absolute levels of the spurious emissions were measured by the substitution.

Spurious emissions in dB = 10 lg (TXpwr in Watts/0.001) – the absolute level




Cellular Band, Left Band Edge for GSM (GMSK) Mode






Cellular Band, Right Band Edge for GSM (GMSK) Mode



Test Procedure

Frequency Stability vs. Temperature: The equipment under test was connected to an external DC power supply and the RF output was connected to communication test set via feed-through attenuators. The EUT was placed inside the temperature chamber. The DC leads and RF output cable exited the chamber through an opening made for the purpose.

After the temperature stabilized for approximately 20 minutes, the frequency output was recorded from the communication test set.

Frequency Stability vs. Voltage: For hand carried, battery powered equipment; reduce primary supply voltage to the battery operating end point which shall be specified by the manufacturer.
