#### 1. Contacts

I In standby mode, enter a number, press the call key pieces to make a call, press the OK key to save

- ♦ If SIM is selected, users can edit name and number.
- ◆ If 'To phone' is selected, the user can edit the name, mobile number, image, ringtone, caller groups

  Standby mode, press the right soft key to enter into the address book or from the menu

  Into the address book, do the following:

[View contact]:view the contact

[Edit]:edit current the contact

[New]: Create a record to phone or SIM

[Delete multiple]: Choose one or more records to delete

[Import/Export]: Copy/Import/Export records to T-Card or phone

## [Others]

[Memory status]: Query the current SIM card and mobile phone storage capacity.

## 2. Messaging

[Write message]

[Inbox]

[Outbox]: Reading or processing stored in the Outbox of the SIM card message.

[Drafts]: Reading or processing stored in the Drafts of the SIM card message

[Sentbox]: read and process the mail stored in the SIM card has been sent information

[Security inbox] View the message which is locked

[Templates]: Use the function of templates

[Broadcast message]: Use the function of broadcast message

[Voice mail server]: use the function of voice mail server

#### 3. Call logs

You can view your recent call situation.

[Missed calls]: Show all missed calls list, select a view after

a missed call occurred the date and time, phone number and times.

[Dialed calls]: Show all dialed calls list, select a view after a dialed calls occurred in the date and time, phone number and times.

[Received calls]: Show all answered the phone list, select a view after a phone that has the date and time of occurrence, telephone number, frequency,

[Rejected calls] Show all refused to answer the phone list, select a view after a missed call occurred the date and time, phone number and times.

Press the OK softkey to enter the options menu can be more than the number of call records in the following:

[Delete all]: Delete all call records

[Call times]: Last time zero starting time for last call statistics, a total of dialed calls, received calls, all calls total, all the time can also be zero.

## 4. Settings

#### 4.1. [Call setting]

**[Dual SIM]** including Standby mode, Reply by original SIM, Set SIM name and Set dual SIM call divert

**[Call Diver]** When "call divert" function is started up, you can transfer the incoming call to voice inbox or other phone number according to the tasked "call divert" conditions

[Call waiting] You can start up or shut down the function. When it is started up, even when you are making a call, you can also receive another income call

**[Call barring]** All outgoing calls, incoming calls, roaming incoming calls, international outgoing calls, roaming international outgoing calls are available.

**[Call time minute reminder]** Select the open or closed during a voice call has prompted

[Auto redial] Select whether to open automatically redial function

[Reply SMS after reject] Select whether to reject messages or return after any key answer

[Auto keypad lock] Set the of mobile phone automatically locked

[Lock screen by end-key] Choose open or closed by red key locking function

[Fixed dialing] Start and close of the fixed dialing, and management of the fixed dialing list

[Blacklist] Set the Settings of the blacklist and management of the list

[Ntwork account] Manage internet account, and support editor and delete.

[GRS Service] Choose turn on or off GPRS service.

[Dta connection settings] Select to connect as needed or all the time

[Ntwork election] Select to automatically or manually connect.

Add: To saved play list, to new play list, to music mark
Set as ring tone: Set the selected MP3 as the call ring or
alarm ring of the incoming call.

Shuffle: Selected the play mode shuffle Repeat: Selected the play mode repeat Settings: Set the music equalizer or BT stereo output or BT stereo headset.

Open review: You can choose to open or close A-B answer read function

Exit: Return to previous menu

[New folder] Create a new folder.

[Delete] delete the specified folder.

[Details] View the folder or file for more information

[Edit] the selected folder or rename the file or copy

[Search] Enter the folder name to find out.

[Sort] By the way you choose to sort the files.

[Mark] Select Mark / Unmark single / all

#### 9. Camera

The device is equipped with a webcam with high pixels. You can take photo at any time and save the photo in the device or SD card. Press OK key to get the picture.

Image viewer: Enter into image browser list.

DV/DC mode: Through this function menu, can switch to frame the menu camera.

Effect: The special effect can be classified into: normal, black and white, blue, green, yellow, red, sepia and negative.

Settings: Including flash, size, quality, banding, shutter sound, auto save, storage etc.

#### 11. Profiles

The preset modes are Normal mode, Silent mode, Indoor mode, Earphone mode and Bluetooth mode. It support

custom profiles, define at most 5 profiles, and users can set the parameters of the profiles.

Instruction: The preset profiles do not support delete, while the custom profiles support delete.

More Functions

Choose one mode, to open the option menu:

[Rename] Rename the current mode.

[Ring settings] Set the SIM1/SIM2 call ring and message ring.

[Adjust volume] Adjust volume for Caller ring tone, Message ring tone, Alarm& calendar ring tone, Call volume and Power ring tone.

[Ring type] Set the SIM1/SIM2 call alert and message alert, alarm & calendar remind.

**[Other alert rings]** Set the other alert rings, such as Key tone, Battery low alert, Power ring tone, Dial tone.

#### 12. Fm radio

You can listen to Fm radio freely. Enter the radio interface. Press the left and right navigation key to switch on a channel and a channel. Press the ok keys to stop/play broadcasting

FM radio. According to \* and adjust the volume # key.

On the interface of the Radio playing, press left soft key you could enter the options menu and do operations follows.

## 13. Text Input

The device provides several text input modes so that you can write text or input data in your "contacts", edit "contacts" record, search English names and write SMS and to-do list.

In "text input" mode, if you want to change the input way, you can press "#" key. The selected input way will appear on the top left of the screen.

## Letter (Capital, Normal)

Enter edit page, press "#"and switch the input mode to "letter", then press the keys on keypad, selected letters will appear on the screen.

Press the number key can get the first letter marked on the key, press twice quickly can get the second letter marked on the key. Similarly, if the letter you want to input have the same key with the former letter, please wait until the cursor appears again, then input the new letter.

For example, if you want to input "ok", you need to press the "6" key three times continuously and get "o", then press the key"5" twice, "k" will appear on the screen. Press right soft key, you can delete the text you input.

#### Number

Enter "edit" mode, press "#" key you can change the input way to "number". Then press the keys, number will appear on the screen. The key 0-9 separately represents the figure from 0 to 9. You can press corresponding key to get desired number. Press right soft key can delete the number you input.

#### 14. Care and Maintenance

### Maintenance of battery

- ·Your device is powered by a rechargeable battery. It is necessary to have the battery charged when it is going to wear out. The full performance of a new battery is achieved only when it is fully wore out.
- ·Unplug the charger from the electrical plug and the device

when not in use. Do not leave fully a charged battery connected to a charger over a week, since overcharging may shorten its lifetime.

- ·Temperature tends to affect the limit of battery to be charged. Therefore, it is necessary for the battery to be cooled or warmed before it is charged. If the temperature of batter exceeds 40°C ,the battery cannot be charged.
- ·Use the battery only for its intended purpose and avoid short-circuiting. Accidental short-circuiting can occur when a metallic object causes direct connection of the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals of the battery.
- Do not use damaged battery.
- ·Leave the battery in hot or cold places will reduce the capacity and lifetime of the battery. A device with a hot or cold battery may not work temporarily, even when the battery is fully charged.
- •Do not dispose of batteries in a fire as they may explode. Dispose of batteries according to local regulations.
