







#### 2 INSTALLATION OF BATTERIES & ANTENNA


- (1) Install 2x1.5V battery according to the polarity marks in the battery compartment.
- (2) Replace the battery cover.
- (3) Locate the hole on the top of the transmitter for installing the antenna. Insert the antenna in and turn clockwise to fix it.
- (4) Correctly install the rechargeable battery pack in the battery compartment and replace the battery
- (5) Fasten the screw with a plus driver.





(3) Timely remove exhausted batteries from the car and the transmitter.

(4) Make sure the main switch is set to OFF before installing the battery pack into the car body.

- (7) Do not short-circuit the batteries.

- (9) Never throw the batteries into fire to avoid explosion or leakage.
- (10) Do not mix batteries from different producers or new and old batteries.
- (11) Use only recommended batteries or equivalent ones.
- (12) Check the batteries on a regular basis to avoid leakage.
