Reference: Request for Special Temporary Authority to Deliver Programs to Foreign Broadcast Station XEMO

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Uniradio Corp. ("Uniradio") of San Diego, California, is filing this request for Special Temporary Authority to make cross-border transmissions of broadcast programs to AM station XEMO in Tijuana, Mexico pursuant to Section 325(c) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 25.120 of the Commission's rules. Uniradio is a California corporation that represents Mexican radio station XEMO in the United States.

The Commission in 2003 granted Uniradio a permit under Section 325(c) to provide cross border delivery of the Spanish language broadcasts of San Diego Padres baseball games and associated pre- and post-game shows. *Permit to Deliver Programs to Foreign Broadcast Stations*, Report No. 325-00051, rel. June 13, 2003. Uniradio transmitted broadcasts of Padres games throughout the 2003-2008 baseball seasons, and it resumed doing so with the beginning of the 2009 baseball season. Uniradio recently discovered that the 2003 permit expired on July 16, 2008.

This STA requests a narrow and temporary authorization to allow Uniradio to continue to deliver to XEMO cross border Spanish language broadcasts of San Diego Padres baseball games and associated pre- and post-game shows. Contemporaneous with the filing of this STA request, Uniradio is filing an application for a new permit under Section 325(c). A copy of that application is attached. The nature of the programming for which the STA is sought is much narrower than that covered by the Section 325(c) application. In addition to the Padres programming, the application requests authorization to deliver other programs in such formats as news, talk, sports, and entertainment, and to do so at various times between 5 a.m. and midnight seven days a week throughout the year.

The programming covered by the STA is both longstanding and unique. For more than six seasons, these broadcasts have allowed, and if the STA is granted will continue to allow, the more than 900,000 Spanish-speaking potential listeners in the XEMO San Diego metro listening area to hear American major league baseball broadcasts in their native language and at no cost. The STA will directly benefit the U.S. economy because advertisers' payments to Uniradio stay in the U.S. In addition, the programming indirectly contributes to the U.S. economy and U.S.-Mexico trade by encouraging Mexican fans to cross the border to attend Padres games and spend their recreation funds in the U.S. Conversely, there will be no harmful or deleterious effects from granting the STA and allowing the Padres broadcasts to continue uninterrupted. Accordingly, grant of this STA will most certainly be in the public interest.

In light of the foregoing, the STA should be granted.
