Application for a new authorization under Section 325 (c) by Latin Western Enterprises Inc., is a permit to deliver programs to XHBK-FM (95.7 MHz) and XEBK-AM (1340 kHz), Nuevo Larado, Tamaulipas, Mexico licensed to Gustavo A. Cortez.

Attached is a copy of the LMA between Latin Western Enterprises, Inc. and Gustavo A. Cortez.

LEASE MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into this 26 day of November, 2014, between GUSTAVO ALONSO CORTEZ MONTIEL (Owner) and FRANCISCO JAVIER CORTEZ DELGADO (General Administrator) of X.E.B.K . 1340 AM and 9.57 FM (combo stations) and DANIEL LOPEZ GARCIA (Leasing Owner).

Both parties agree that a monthly rent of \$20,000 dollars will be paid on 1st day of each month until this agreement expires on December 1st, 2019. When the 1st day of the month falls on a Sunday, the rent due date will be on the following Monday on 2nd day of the month.

Leasing Owner agrees to observe Mexico Programming rules regarding spots that may be generated and dictated by the Mexican Federal Government to be on the air.

Leasing Owner agrees to maintain a professional relationship with Syndicated Institution which collaborates with employees working in Mexico for the radio station and to observe existing rules.

This Lease Management Agreement begins on December 1, 2014 and will end December 1, 2019. That is a term of 5 years from date of commencement. Upon expiration of the above initial term, this Agreement shall be renewed and extended if both parties agree on renewal conditions.

A survey to evaluate property conditions and maintenance of contract will be executed on the month of May of each year throughout the 5 year term of this contract.

Leasing Owner will be responsible for repairs and maintenance of A.M. and F.M. transmitters and engineering equipment at studios and for payroll wages for syndicated employees. Holidays will be arranged directly with the syndicated representative of the Radio and Television in the Nuevo Laredo section. The existing HARRIS transmitting equipment for the A.M. and F.M. stations should remain where they are now and will receive signal and programming audio that will generate from Laredo Texas into Nuevo Laredo, Tamaulipas, either via Internet, by phone or from Production Studios in Laredo, Texas.

Any clauses and conditions not stated here that may directly affect either the Owner or the Leasing Owner will be discussed in a meeting with the Syndicated Institution representing the station for the betterment of this Agreement.

Leasing Owner will be responsible for monthly copy rights of music played at stations and will ensure to pay on due dates including yearly increase rates that may be in effect at moment of payment.

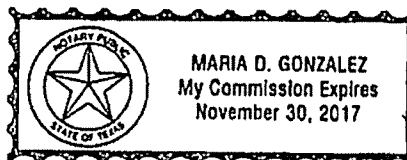

Description of Programming

The applicant proposes to deliver music and news programming to XEBK-AM (1340 kHz) and XHBK-FM (95.7 MHz), these stations serve Nuevo Laredo, Tamaulipas, Mexico, and transmit simultaneously. The programming will be delivered in Spanish. The service will be regularly scheduled 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, in accordance with the LMA attached in Exhibit 1.
