The following condition applies when this authorization permits construction of or modifies the construction permit of a radio station.

This authorization shall be automatically forfeited if the station is not ready for operation by the required date of completion of construction unless an application for modification of authorization to request additional time to complete construction is filed by that date, together with a showing that failure to complete construction by the required date was due to factors not under control of the grantee.

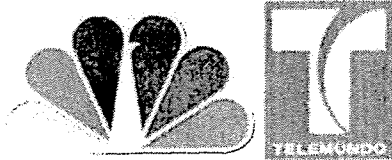

NBC Telemundo License Co. ("LicenseCo"), licensee of multiple U.S. full-power television stations affiliated with the Telemundo broadcast network (the "Telemundo Network") and under common control with the Telemundo Network, hereby requests Commission authorization to deliver program material from the Telemundo Network to Mexican Television Broadcast Station XHAS(TV), Tijuana, Baja California, Mexico (the "Station"), the signals of which are consistently received within the United States, in accordance with requirements under Section 325(c) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.¹

The Station is to function as a Telemundo Network affiliate, primarily carrying Telemundo Network programming (along with some local programming). The Telemundo Network is a full service Spanish language programmer, providing a full slate of news, informational and entertainment programming, as well as Spanish-language children's informational and educational programming meeting the requirements of the Children's Television Act as implemented by the Commission. Grant of this application will allow the Telemundo Network to maintain its coverage in the San Diego-Tijuana area, including its news coverage, and to better serve the needs of the Hispanic community. Accordingly, grant of the requested authorization will serve the public interest.

¹ The instructions for FCC Form 308, which is used to apply for Section 325(c) permits, expressly states that an applicant holding a valid radio or television broadcast license, such as LicenseCo, may use an informal application, such as the instant request, in lieu of Form 308.

In January 2001, the Commission granted a permit under Section 325(c) (the "2001 Permit") to Telemundo Network Group, LLC ("Permittee"), authorizing the Permittee to deliver Telemundo Network programming to the Station. See FCC File No. 325-NEW-20001122-00015. The following year, in April 2002 and pursuant to prior Commission consent, the Permittee's parent corporation, Telemundo Communications Group, Inc., was merged into and with TN Acquisition Corp., a wholly owned subsidiary of General Electric Company, which is the ultimate parent corporation of LicenseCo. See FCC File BALCT-20011101ABW, *et seq.* Following the merger, the merged company continued to provide Telemundo Network programming to the Station pursuant to the 2001 Permit.

Recently, in the process of an internal review of Telemundo Network's records, it was determined that the 2001 Permit had expired earlier this year.² LicenseCo respectfully requests the Commission to grant it a new authorization so that the Telemundo Network programming described above may continue to be delivered to the Station.³ LicenseCo has taken steps to ensure ongoing and future compliance with Commission requirements in this matter.⁴

The International Bureau very recently described the two-fold purpose of Section 325(c) as (1) addressing objectionable programming and (2) protecting against harmful interference by foreign stations.⁵ As is well known to the Commission, the Telemundo Network produces and distributes programming that is recognized to serve the public interest in America. Accordingly, grant of the requested authorization would serve the positive purpose of allowing the Station to continue receiving Telemundo Network programming. With respect to the second purpose – protecting against harmful interference – the Commission previously has determined that the Station is (and remains) eligible to receive programming from U.S. entities and has

³ This is the first time that Telemundo, under its current ownership, was to have renewed the 2001 Permit. The oversight occurred, in part, due to the failure of the prior owners to list the permit in the schedules of authorizations to be transferred as part of the merger, which in turn may have resulted from confusion over whether the rules require or allow such permits to be transferred, as there is no specific rule addressing the transferability of Section 325(c) permits nor do the Commission's rules specify a filing fee for transfer of Section 325(c) permits.

⁴ As part of these efforts, the instant application requests that the Section 325(c) authorization be issued to LicenseCo, which is the primary license-holding vehicle for the Telemundo-owned and operated stations. LicenseCo has systems and procedures in place to track and maintain FCC authorizations and to ensure the timely filing of renewal applications for such authorizations. Also, in order to maintain broadcast service, LicenseCo is simultaneously filing a request for special temporary authority to continue to provide programming to the Station while this request is pending.



therefore granted a permit authorizing the transmission of programming to the Station (the "2002 Permit").⁶ The Commission thus has concluded that the Station is operating within its operating parameters and does not pose a risk of harmful interference. The 2002 Permit is not scheduled to expire until September 2007. Accordingly, the Station has remained and will remain subject to Commission oversight as a result of the prior grant of the 2002 Permit and the grant of the permit requested herein.

For the foregoing reasons, LicenseCo requests the Commission to grant its application for a Section 325(c) permit authorizing it to transmit Telemundo Network programming to the Station. Notice will be published in a daily newspaper of general circulation and proof of publication submitted, as per 47 C.F.R. § 73.3580.
