This authorization is issued on the grantee's representation that the station is in compliance with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements as set forth in Section 17.4 of the Commission's Rules. 47 C.F.R. § 17.4.

The following condition applies when this authorization permits construction of or modifies the construction permit of a radio station.

This authorization shall be automatically forfeited if the station is not ready for operation by the required date of completion of construction unless an application for modification of authorization to request additional time to complete construction is filed by that date, together with a showing that failure to complete construction by the required date was due to factors not under control of the grantee.

**Comprehensive Exhibit**

Local Media San Diego, LLC (“Local Media”), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Local Media of America Holdings, LLC (“Local Media Holdings”), is the holder of an authorization (“325(c) Authorization”) issued under Section 325(c) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to deliver programming to XETRA-FM, 91.1 MHz; XHITZ-FM, 90.3 MHz; and XHRM-FM, 92.5 MHz (collectively “Stations”). The 325(c) Authorization was issued on February 19, 2010 and is scheduled to expire on February 19, 2015.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, Local Media is filing the instant application to seek renewal of the 325(c) Authorization.

**I. OWNERSHIP MATTERS**

Local Media, the current holder of the Section 325(c) authorization, is a Delaware limited liability company. Local Media is managed by a board of managers consisting of Christine Bucklin, John Gehron, James Lines, Steve McNeely, Lee Mitchell and Carl Thoma. The sole voting member of Local Media is Local Media Holdings, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company. The sole member and manager of Local Media Holdings is Thoma Bravo Fund IX, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership (“TBF LP”). The sole general partner of TBF LP is Thoma Bravo Partners IX, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership (“TBF Partners LP”). Thoma Bravo, LLC (“Thoma Bravo”), in turn, is the sole general partner of TB Partners LP. Thoma Bravo is managed by a board of managers consisting of Orlando Bravo, S. Scott Crabill, Seth Boro, Holden Spaht, Lee M. Mitchell, and Carl D. Thoma. Each of these individuals holds more than 10%, but less than 25%, of the ownership interests in Thoma Bravo.

Foreign Ownership. Seth Boro, a member of the board of managers of Thoma Bravo, is a Canadian citizen. Other than Mr. Boro, no party to this application is an alien, a foreign government, a corporation organized under the laws of a foreign country, or a representative of any of the foregoing.

Other Broadcast Interests. Other than the Section 325(c) Authorization, neither the applicant nor any principal thereof holds an attributable interest in any broadcast station licensed by the FCC, or pending application before the FCC for a new broadcast station.

<sup>1</sup> The Section 325(c) Authorization was modified on February 6, 2014 to (1) reflect a change in name from Local Media of America, LLC to Local Media San Diego, LLC; (2) update the address for the studio location set forth in Section A of the Section 325(c) Authorization; and (3) revise Section C of the Section 325(c) Authorization to reflect that rather than deliver the programming by satellite, the programming is delivered “by means of fiber optic transmission lines, with backup using traditional telephone lines and/or 4G cellular transmissions, if necessary.”

**II. NATURE OF THE PROGRAMMING**

The Stations, which serve the San Diego radio market, are assigned to Tijuana, B.C., Mexico. The originating facilities are owned by Comunicaciones Xersa, S.A. de C.V. ("Xersa"). Since the Section 325(c) Authorization was issued in 2010, Local Media has provided programming for the Stations pursuant to an Exclusive Promotional, Programming, and Sales Agreement ("Programming Agreement"). The Programming Agreement contains propriety information and will be provided to the Federal Communications Commission upon request. Program deliveries to the Stations include regularly scheduled and special feature programming for up to 24 hours per day, seven days per week, throughout the year, subject to Xersa's Mexican programming obligations. The program deliveries consists of entertainment, news, sports, weather, traffic, information and/or other broadcast material in the English language. The program deliveries following renewal of the Section 325(c) Authorization will be unchanged from the programming delivered to the Stations by Local Media as of the date hereof.
