Dear Ms. Salas:

Pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order, CC Docket No. 90-337, 6 FCC Rcd. 3552 (1991) (Regulation of International Accounting Rates, Phase 1), MCI WorldCom, Inc. ("MCIWorldCom") hereby informs the Commission of its intention to establish the accounting rate for its International Switched Voice Service between MCI WorldCom and its correspondent, Pacifictel S.A. ("Pacifictel"). This modification request applies only to the traffic stream of the former MCI Telecommunications Corporation, which recently merged with WorldCom, Inc.

The proposed accounting rates for this service as agreed to between the parties are displayed in the attached Supplementary Data Statement. The accounting rate will continue to be divided on a 50/50 basis. Other than the accounting rate change, no other modifications have been made to the operating agreement.

The proposed change in the accounting rate is in the U.S. public interest in that it will provide the earliest possible reductions in the accounting rate and the U.S. settlement outpayment, and is not in any way designed to enrich the foreign correspondent.

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Copies of this modification have been sent to the other carriers providing International Switched Voice Service between the United States and Ecuador.

I, Nakul Rege, being duly sworn, state under the penalties of perjury, as follows:



2. I am responsible for the accounting rate negotiations with Pacifictel S.A.; MCI WorldCom's correspondent in Ecuador that resulted in the accounting rate change contained in the accompanying notification filed with the Commission herewith. I am making this affidavit based on my knowledge of the accounting rate negotiations with Pacifictel S.A. and the representations of MCI WorldCom's country manager for Ecuador who participated in the accounting rate negotiations with Pacifictel S.A.
3. MCI WorldCom has not bargained for, and has no knowledge of, exclusive availability of the new accounting rate with Pacifictel S.A. MCI WorldCom has informed the foreign administration that U.S. policy requires that competing carriers have access to accounting rates negotiated by the filing carriers with the foreign carriers on a non-discriminatory basis.
4. MCI WorldCom has not bargained for more than its proportionate share of return traffic. As a result of these negotiations, MCII has no indication that it will receive more than its proportionate share of return traffic.
