
Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order, CC Docket No. 90-337, 6 FCC Rcd. 3552 (1991) (Regulation of International Accounting Rates, Phase 1), MCI International, Inc. ("MCI") hereby informs the Commission of its intention to change the accounting rate for its International Message Telephone Service between MCI and its correspondent, Liberia Telecommunications Corporation "LTC" in Liberia.

The current and proposed accounting rates for this service, as agreed to between the parties, are displayed in the attached Supplementary Data Statement. The accounting rate will continue to be divided on a 50/50 basis. Other than the accounting rate change, no other modifications have been made to the operating agreement.

The proposed change in the accounting rate is in the U.S. public interest in that it will provide the earliest possible reductions in the accounting rate and the U.S. settlement outpayment, and is not in any way designed to enrich the foreign correspondent.


I, Nakul Rege, being duly sworn, state under the penalties of perjury, as follows:

1. I am the Director of Accounting Rates and Transits at MCI International, Inc. ("MCI"). My business address is Two International Drive, Rye Brook, New York, 10573.
2. I am responsible for the accounting rate negotiations with Liberia Telecommunications Corporation "LTC", MCI's correspondent in Liberia that resulted in the accounting rate change contained in the accompanying notification filed with the Commission herewith. I am making this affidavit based on my knowledge of the accounting rate negotiations with LTC and the representations of MCI's country manager for Liberia who participated in the accounting rate negotiations with LTC.
3. MCI has not bargained for, and has no knowledge of, exclusive availability of the new accounting rate with LTC. MCI has informed the foreign administration that U.S. policy requires that competing carriers have access to accounting rates negotiated by the filing carriers with the foreign carriers on a non-discriminatory basis.
4. MCI has not bargained for more than its proportionate share of return traffic. As a result of these negotiations, MCI has no indication that it will receive more than its proportionate share of return traffic.
