On behalf of Radiate Holdings, L.P. and pursuant to Section 63.24(e) of the Commission's rules, this letter provides notice that the above-referenced transaction was consummated. Radiate filed an application for consent to the transfer of control of international section 214 authorizations, ITC-214-19961004-00490; ITC-214-19970717-00411; ITC-214-19970723-00430; and ITC-214-19981002-00679, on September 1, 2016.<sup>1/</sup> The Commission granted the transfer of control with respect to this authorization on November 23, 2016.<sup>2/</sup> The Transaction closed February 1, 2017. Please note that the holder of the license, RCN Telecom Services (Lehigh) LLC, a subsidiary of RCN, has not changed.
