Response to 12(c) and 16: Effective December 2, 2010, the parent company of France Telecom Long Distance USA, LLC (“FTLD”), France Télécom S.A., acquired a 40% interest in Méditel, a competitive wireless and wireline provider in Morocco. Morocco is a member of the WTO. Méditel was created in 1999 and lacks 50 percent market share in the international transport and the local access markets on the foreign end of the route. Méditel is not listed on the FCC’s list of providers presumed to have market power.

Response to 17: Méditel is authorized to operate in Morocco.

Response to 18: FTL D is authorized to provide facilities based and resold services to Morocco pursuant to Section 214 authorization, ITC-214-1999-1215-00783, dated January 6, 2000.

Response to 19: None.

Response to 20: FTL D submits the following information concerning its ten percent or greater direct and indirect shareholder or other equity holders. FTL D is wholly owned by France Telecom Participations Holding Inc. (a U.S. holding company). France Telecom Participations Holding Inc. is wholly-owned by France Telecom Participations U.S., Inc. (a U.S. holding company), which is wholly-owned by France Télécom S.A. (a French telecommunications company). France Télécom S.A. is a publicly traded company on the New York Stock Exchange and the Euronext Paris. As of Nov. 30, 2010, the French State owns 27% of France Télécom S.A. There are no other 10% or greater direct or indirect shareholders of France Télécom S.A.
