

**AMENDMENT TO
FOREIGN CARRIER AFFILIATION NOTIFICATION**

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.744 and 1.768, AST Telecom, LLC d/b/a Bluesky (“AST”), American Samoa Hawaii Cable, LLC (“ASHC”), and Samoa American Samoa Cable, LLC (“SASC,” together with AST and ASHC, “Cable Landing Licensees”) amend their pending foreign carrier affiliation notification (FCC File No. FCN-NEW-20110316-00003, as modified by August 20, 2012 amendment reflecting Independent Samoa’s subsequent membership in the World Trade Organization) with respect to their affiliation with Bluesky Samoa Limited (formerly known as SamoaTel Limited). The Cable Landing Licensees initially filed the notification on March 15, 2011 with respect to the American Samoa Hawaii Cable System, which the Commission licensed on January 9, 2009.¹

The Cable Landing Licensees hereby withdraw without prejudice their request for non-dominant carrier status for the Samoa-American Samoa route for their pending foreign carrier affiliation notification, reserving their right to seek reclassification at a future date. The Cable Landing Licensees agree to comply with the dominant carrier regulations provided in 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.767(l) and 63.10(c).
