**Foreign Carrier Affiliation Notification**

Pursuant to Section 63.11 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.11(c), StarHub, Inc. ("StarHub") hereby submits this foreign carrier affiliation notification in connection with new affiliations with subsidiaries or affiliates of Level 3 Communications, Inc. ("Level 3") in the following countries: Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Ecuador, Finland, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Luxembourg, Mexico, the Netherlands, Norway, Panama, Peru, Poland, Romania, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, the United Kingdom, Uruguay, and Venezuela. These affiliations arose when StarHub's indirect parent, Singapore Technologies Telemedia Pte Ltd ("ST Telemedia"), increased its interest in Level 3 to exceed the 25-percent threshold. Specifically, through a series of open market purchases of Level 3 common stock that concluded on or about May 18, 2012, ST Telemedia increased its interest in Level 3 to approximately 25.6 percent.<sup>1</sup>

**Answers to Questions 12 and 16**

To the best of StarHub's knowledge based on publicly available sources, StarHub's foreign carrier affiliates own or lease facilities in their respective markets.

Each of StarHub's foreign carrier affiliates is authorized to operate in World Trade Organization ("WTO") Member country.

With the exception of the U.S.-Singapore route (for which StarHub already is treated as dominant due to an existing affiliation), StarHub is entitled to non-dominant classification on its newly affiliated routes. According to publicly available sources (including Level 3's prior filings with the Commission), each of StarHub's foreign carrier affiliates lacks a 50 percent market share, and none is listed on the Commission's List of Foreign Telecommunications Carriers That Are Presumed to Possess Market Power in Foreign Telecommunications Markets.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, these foreign carriers qualify for a presumption of non-dominance pursuant to Section 63.10(a)(3) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.10(a)(3), and StarHub requests continued regulation as a non-dominant international carrier pursuant to that section (again with the exception of the U.S.-Singapore route).<sup>3</sup>
