Response to Question 10

GTI Corporation ("GTI") files this notification pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.11(b)(1)(i) and (b)(2)(i). As GTI as previously certified, Singapore Telecommunications International Private Ltd. ("SingTel International") owns approximately 47 percent of the common shares of GTI's indirect parent, Globe Telecom, Inc. ("Globe"). Since the Commission authorized GTI in 2010 to provide international telecommunications services, GTI has become affiliated with additional foreign carriers as a consequence of transactions undertaken by SingTel International's direct and indirect parent companies.

GTI was not notified by SingTel International of these foreign affiliations. SingTel International does not control GTI or Globe.³ GTI relied on publicly available information to determine its foreign affiliations acquired through SingTel International.⁴

Response to Question 12(b)

GTI presumes that its new foreign-carrier affiliates in China, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Thailand, and the United Kingdom each own or lease facilities in their respective markets, but has no direct knowledge of these facts.

Response to Question 12(c)(1)

GTI is eligible for post-consummation notification of foreign affiliations pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.11(b)(1)(i) and (b)(2)(i).

With respect to the carriers identified by an asterisk (*) in Table 1 below, GTI is entitled to retain non-dominant status on the associated international routes pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.10(a)(3) and 63.11(b)(1)(i). The Commission has previously acknowledged that these carriers lack market power in their respective geographic markets. Each of these foreign carriers has less than 50-percent market share in either the international transport market or local access market of its respective geographic market. None of these newly-affiliated foreign carriers has since appeared on the Commission's list of foreign telecommunications carriers presumed to possess market power in foreign telecommunications markets. 6

With respect to the other foreign carrier listed in Table 1 below (*i.e.*, TeleChoice Philippines, Inc.), GTI is entitled to retain non-dominant status on the associated international route pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.10(a)(3) and 63.11(b)(2)(i). TeleChoice Philippines, Inc. lacks market power in its geographic market. It has less than 50-percent market share in either the international transport market or local access market of its respective geographic market. TeleChoice Philippines, Inc. does not appear on the Commission's list of foreign telecommunications carriers presumed to possess market power in foreign telecommunications markets. GTI therefore continues to qualify for a presumption of non-dominance on the U.S.-Philippines route pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.10(a)(3) and exemption from the dominant carrier safeguards in 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.10(c) through (e). GTI certifies that TeleChoice Philippines, Inc. is authorized to operate in the Philippines, which is a member of the World Trade Organization ("WTO").8

Response to Question 16

For the reasons set forth in response to Question 12(c)(1) above, GTI continues to qualify for and requests continued regulation as a non-dominant international carrier on all authorized routes, including routes for which it has new foreign-carrier affiliates. All of the foreign carrier affiliates listed in Table 1 below lack market power in WTO countries, entitling GTI to be classified presumptively as non-dominant. GTI did not seek and does not have authority to serve the U.S.-Singapore route.
