

Supplemental Information (Questions 17 to 21)

Affiliated Foreign Carriers

Transtelco, Inc. (“Transtelco”) is under common ownership with two small carriers that have limited operations in Mexico: IP Matrix, SA de CV, which provides local voice and data service, and Olatu Networks, SA de CV, which provides long distance service. Each company is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Transtelco Holding, Inc., which is Transtelco’s parent company.

Transtelco is authorized to provide both facilities-based service under Section 63.18(e)(1) and resale service under Section 63.18(e)(2) of the FCC’s Rules pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act, authority which was granted under FCC File No. ITC-214-20070228-00088. An application seeking FCC approval of a previously-consummated transfer of control of this authorization (IBFS Submission ID: IB2015000039) has been filed contemporaneously with this notice. The ownership information provided with that application is also provided below in the Ownership section. Transtelco currently does not provide common carrier services within the United States.

Transtelco does not serve Mexico solely through the resale of international switched services of unaffiliated U.S. facilities-based carriers. Indeed, the bulk of its services are facilities-based and are offered on a private contract basis.

Ownership

Axiscom, SA. de CV, which owns approximately 39% of Transtelco, is an investment company formed in Mexico by relatives of Miguel and Rodrigo Fernandez, most of whom are citizens of Mexico. Finestra, SA de CV, which owns 15% of Transtelco, is a holding company based in Mexico controlled by Fernando de Jesus Canales Clariond, a citizen of Mexico and a prominent investor and businessman. Mr. Canales can be reached at Rio Lerma 120, Col. Miravalle, Monterrey, Nuevo Leon 64660, Mexico.

Miguel and Rodrigo Fernandez, both of whom are U.S. citizens, each control 20% of Transtelco. Each can be reached at the company’s headquarters at 500 West Overland Avenue, Suite 310, El Paso, Texas 79901.

Interlocking Directorates

Miguel and Rodrigo Fernandez, the CEO and COO of Transtelco, are also officers and directors of IP Matrix and Olatu Networks.
