**AMENDMENT TO  
PETITION OF CHOICE HOLDINGS LLC  
FOR DECLARATORY RULING UNDER SECTION 310(b)(4) OF  
THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 1934, AS AMENDED**

Choice Holdings LLC (“Choice Holdings” or “Company”) hereby submits this amendment to its July 26, 2011 (IBFS File No. ISP-PDR-20110726-00007)<sup>1</sup> petition for declaratory (the “Petition”) ruling pursuant to Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the “Act”), and the *Foreign Participation Order*.<sup>2</sup> Choice Holdings requests that the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) consider the Petition hereby amended so that any and all requests for Section 310(b)(4) authorization made thereunder would only apply to the specific Wireless Communications Service license (KNLB242) at issue in the assignment of authorization application from Cellutec, Inc. (FRN 0002147668) to Choice Phone, LLC (FRN 0004242475).<sup>3</sup> As a result, Choice Holdings shall seek additional

authorization under Section 310(b)(4) of the Act should it seek to obtain any other wireless licenses in the future. In accordance with this amendment to the Petition, Choice Holdings respectfully requests that the Commission extend its prior declaratory rulings to find that Choice Phone, LLC's proposed indirect foreign ownership of over 25% in the WCS license, call sign KNLB242, is permissible under Section 310(b)(4) of the Act, is consistent with the Commission's prior rulings, and is in the public interest.
