Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Trident Global Communications LLC ("Trident"), this is to amend the above-referenced Petition for Declaratory Ruling, filed pursuant to Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, for a determination that the public interest does not prohibit Trident's acquisition of PetroCom License Corporation ("PetroCom") given the current level of indirect foreign ownership in Trident held by Kactus Investment Corporation, a Cayman Islands corporation.

Specifically, the present amendment is filed to report that, in the Commission's recently-concluded Auction 66 of licenses in the Advanced Wireless Services ("AWS"), PetroCom was the high bidder for two AWS licenses. PetroCom filed its long-form application (File No. 0002773319) for these licenses on October 3, 2006, which application remains pending before the Commission. Trident and PetroCom therefore respectfully request that any ruling issued by the Commission in connection with the above-referenced Petition for Declaratory Ruling also encompass PetroCom's ability to acquire and hold AWS licenses in addition to licenses in the radio services identified in the Petition as originally filed.
