Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 10, 2007, Digicel (USVI) LLC ("Digicel") filed a petition with the Commission under Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 310(b)(4), requesting a declaratory ruling that its foreign ownership in excess of 25 percent would not be contrary to the public interest. The petition was submitted concurrently with an application to the Commission for its consent to the assignment to Digicel of the PCS license of Elandia Technologies, Inc. ("Elandia"), call sign WPOJ804, in BTA 491.

Digicel recently exercised an option to terminate its Asset Purchase Agreement with Elandia for acquisition of the PCS license. As a result of the termination of the underlying transaction, Digicel's subject petition for declaratory ruling has been rendered moot and does not require further consideration by the Commission. The parties have, as a result of this termination, withdrawn their application for the Commission's consent to assignment of call sign WPOJ804.

Digicel hereby withdraws its petition for declaratory ruling, as well. Thank you for your consideration of Digicel's petition. We look forward to working with you again on a future occasion.
