
Dear Ms. Dortch:

Alexandra Field, SVP TerreStar Networks, spoke with Howard Griboff, Deputy Chief, Policy Division, IB, in a series of phone calls between November 12 and November 30 regarding the status of TerreStar's Petition for Declaratory Ruling. In those calls, Ms. Field inquired as to the possible timing of a decision on the petition for purposes of accurate disclosures in TerreStar's upcoming year-end reporting obligations, currently scheduled for December 15. In particular, Ms. Field expressed an interest in ensuring that TerreStar take whatever actions the Commission might need to help avoid any administrative delay. The calls were not intended to address the merits or outcome of the proceeding, and were focused on the question of the approximate time that Commission action might be taken. While TerreStar does not believe that these communications require notice under Section 1.202 of the Commission's rules, TerreStar is filing this notice to ensure transparency.
