T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") supplements the above-referenced petition for declaratory ruling under Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended ("Petition"), to allow up to 100 percent indirect foreign ownership in Cook Inlet GSM PCS Holdings, LLC ("Cook IV"), an indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of T-Mobile, which in turn, is a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of Deutsche Telekom AG ("DT"), a publicly traded German corporation.

On July 6, 2009, T-Mobile effectuated an internal corporate reorganization that resulted in the dissolution of an intermediate-tier holding company between T-Mobile and its parent company DT. As noted in the Petition, T-Mobile International AG ("TMIAG") previously was a wholly-owned direct subsidiary of DT and the 100 percent direct parent company of T-Mobile Global Holding GmbH ("TMGH"), which directly holds 100 percent of the ownership interests of T-Mobile. Upon TMIAG's dissolution on July 6, TGHG became a wholly-owned direct subsidiary of DT. The attached chart illustrates T-Mobile's current ownership structure after the reorganization.
